FINANCING PROGRAMS

VERMONT WASTEWATER AND POTABLE WATER REVOLVING LOAN FUND

On-site Loan Program

In 2012 the Vermont Legislature established the Vermont Wastewater and Potable Water Revolving Loan Fund (On-site Loan Program) to provide homeowners a source of low-cost financing for the repair or replacement of failed septic and/or water supply systems. The goal of this program is to protect both public health and the environment while assisting Vermonters with limited financial resources to upgrade increasingly expensive failed systems.

Program Eligibility

- The wastewater or potable (drinking) water supply has been confirmed to be a failed system.
- Repair or replacement of the failed system is needed.
- The failed system must serve only one single family residence on its own lot.
- Loan recipient must reside in the residence year-round.
- Gross household income of the loan recipient must be equal to or less than 200 percent of the state median household income.
- Owner has been denied financing for the repair or replacement of the failed system by at least one financing entity.

How to Apply

- Complete the pre-qualification form
- Obtain potable water and wastewater system construction permit from the Regional Office serving your area
- Obtain a minimum of two construction bids for the project
- Complete the loan application through the Program's contracted lender, Opportunities Credit Union

The On-site Loan Program is funded and administered by the Agency of Natural Resources, Department of Environmental Conservation with loan underwriting and servicing provided by the Opportunities Credit Union in Winooski, Vermont.
