- Gain an overview of heath care in Bhutan from discussions with national leaders as well as visits to hospitals and clinics providing primary and specialized health care in both urban and rural settings.

• Interact with a non-profit organization like **Draktsho**. They are one of a kind in Bhutan and aspire to enhance the living standard of children and youth with various types of disabilities through empowerment by training, and eventual integration with the mainstream population.
