

ORDINANCE NO. 462

**AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN
LAND INTO THE CITY BY PETITION and CONSENT.**

WHEREAS, a petition and consent to annexation has been received by the City of Edna, Kansas for the annexation of the following described real property into the City boundary; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-520 et seq. the City may annex adjoining land into the City upon petition and or consent by the owner; and

WHEREAS, the Council upon due consideration finds that the annexation as petitioned and consented to is adjoining land and is in the best interest of the parties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDNA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the petition of Ricky D. Wood owner of the following described real property, to wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 30, Township 34, Range 19, East of the 6th P.M., thence West 14 rods, thence North 11½ rods, thence East 14 rods, thence South 11½ rods to beginning, except so much thereof as is used for public highway or road, Labette County, Kansas.

And

Tract 1. Commencing at a point 11½ rods North and 150 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 30, Township 34, Range 19, thence North 100 feet, thence West 47 feet, thence South 100 feet, thence East 47 feet to the point of beginning.

Tract 2. Commencing at the point 11½ rods North of the Southeast corner of Section 30, Township 34, Range 19, thence North 100 feet, thence West 150 feet, thence South 100 feet, thence East to the point of beginning, except so much thereof as is deeded or used for public highway or road, Labette County, Kansas


Tract 1 and 2. Commonly known as: 998 4000 Rd and 4004 State Hwy 101, Edna, Kansas

for annexation into the City boundary be and hereby is granted and ordered annexed into the City.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is hereby ordered to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Labette County Clerk and Register of Deeds.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of said City.
