The Diocese of Salt Lake City is seeking men who are discerning a call to the diaconate for a new class of deacons. Aspirants must be Catholics in good standing between the ages of 36 and 61 (the Bishop can grant exceptions to the age limits). If married, the candidate must have his wife's support. The program, which lasts approximately five years, includes twice-monthly classes in English.

Spiritual Adoption

Month 2-Developing Baby-"I'm dancing!"

Your baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby-teeth buds are present at 6 1/2 weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, your spiritually adopted baby grows and refines her body. But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a "fetus"-a Latin word meaning "little one". An ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip and jump-her first dance steps!
