All teams will bowl (12) twelve baker games, moving one lane after each game. The top (8) eight teams, based on the total scores, will advance to the Championship Round pairing highest seed vs lowest seed (1-8, 2-7, 3-6, 4-5). The winner of the best (2) two out of (3) three head-to-head baker games will advance each round. The Championship round will be best of (5) five. The tournament directors will be the officials for this tournament.

Awards: 1st and 2nd place teams will receive a team trophy and individual player medals.

CHANGES TO TOURNAMENT FORMAT/OPERATION DUE TO COVID-19

Below are changes to Huron Baker Tournament format and policies as of October 12, 2020 due to COVID-19. The items below will be enforced by tournament officials and bowling center owner/operators (and also appreciated by visiting coaches).

- 1. The maximum number roster size per team has been reduced to six (6). Do NOT bring additional dressed athletes.
- 2. Athletes must use his/her own equipment. Each athlete may only bring 3 bowling balls.
- 3. The maximum number of teams that can participate remains at 16 per session (host team is one of the 16 leaving 15 entries).
- 4. The maximum number of spectators allowed per team is six (6). Coaches will receive 6 vouchers to distribute as desired to parents/spectator athletes.
- 5. Everyone is to wear a mask. This includes bowlers, all coaches and spectators. Bowler may remove mask during their turn to bowl but must re-apply mask at completion of frame.
- 6. Lane assignments will stay in pods of 4 moving one lane right after each game, but pod will NOT move to next set of 4 lanes as years past. Thus each team will bowl same set of 4 lanes three (3) times.

Any changes to format prior to tournament will be communicated to coaches by email provided in above form. These policies are intended to provide the safest environment while still conducting the tournament as "normal" as possible.
