After nine years of ministry as a Director of Faith Formation, Mrs. Heather Bonn asked to retire from that position and pass the torch to someone else. On behalf of all of you, I would like to express our deepest gratitude to Heather for her efficient and gracious leadership in the ministry of Faith Formation at Saint Olaf. However, her dedicated service to faith formation at our parish goes way beyond that. Heather began in 1986 teaching children and youth in Kindergarten, First Grade, Third Grade and RCIA. All together 25 years of dedication and love for God and His Church. May God be your reward, Heather.

Thankfully, she is not leaving the ministry but accepted coordination of the RCIA Program that was run by Deacon Scott Dodge, who has been appointed as head of the Diocesan Ministry of Permanent Deacons. It is a great act of faith and trust in Deacon's knowledge and skill on the part of Bishop Solis to entrust this position to Deacon Scott. This position will limit Deacon's involvement in the ministry to RCIA, Baptism and Marriage preparation he has been doing at Saint Olaf, but thankfully Deacon Scott will continue weekend ministry at Mass and preaching. Thank you Deacon Scott Dodge on my own behalf and all at Saint Olaf.

Last, but not least, we have a new Director of Faith Formation at Saint Olaf. Carol A. Welninski graciously accepted my invitation to take over Saint Olaf's Faith Formation Program. Carol has been a member of Saint Olaf since 1992. Her background is in nursing, as she graduated in 1970 with an Associates Degree and gained consequently bachelors and Masters Degrees as a Registered Nurse. In 1985, she joined the Air Force Reserves and flew aerovac missions for three years. Her service took her to the Netherlands and England before settling in Utah.

During her nursing career, she also obtained teaching skills as an instructor, teaching Advanced Life Support and National EMT courses to nurses, doctors and allied health professionals. Her most recent job, before retirement was at Weber State University for Annie D. Taylor School of Nursing from 1992-2018. She taught there as an assistant professor for first semester lab and clinical courses.

Luckily for us, she followed the call in her heart and joined the parish ministry of Faith Formation as a Confirmation teacher in 2018. I feel blessed to entrust Carol A. Welninski the ministry of Faith formation at Saint Olaf beginning July 1, 2020.
