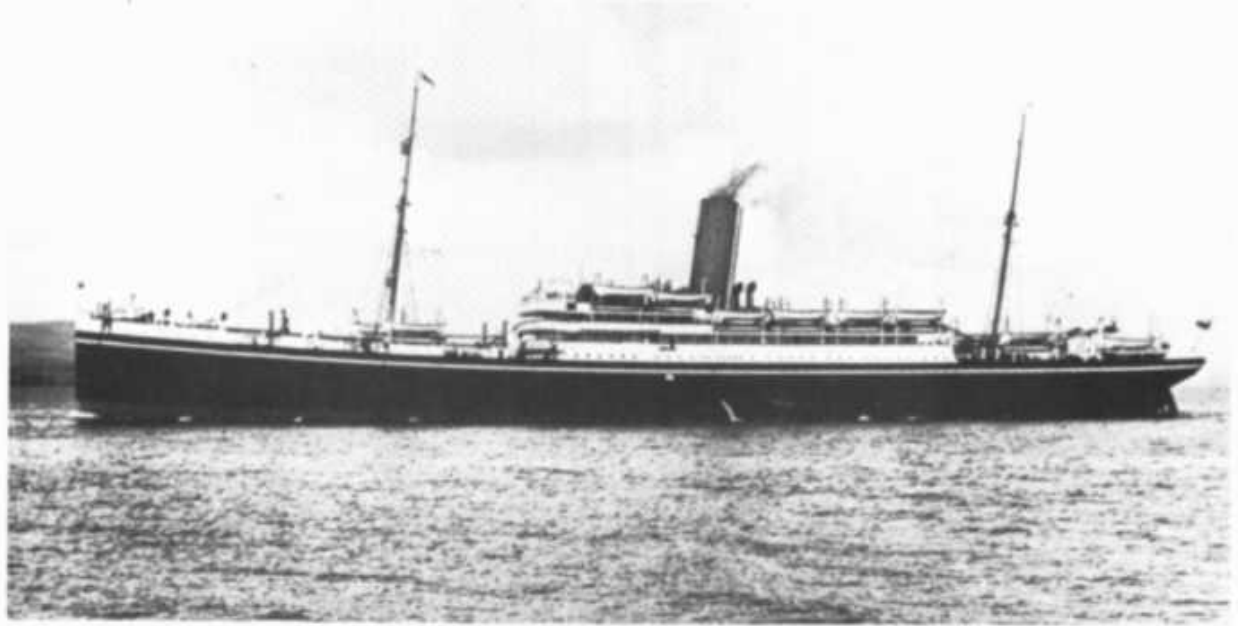


# S.S. Tunisian

History:	Passengers: 240 first, 220 second, 1,000 third. Commenced her maiden voyage from Liverpool to Canada in April 1900. Transferred to Canadian Pacific Line during World War II. Renamed: Marburn (1922). Scrapped in 1928. Sister ship: Bavarian.
