Dear Friends:

Again, this Sunday we will gather as a community for worship, prayers, and praises. As we prepare our hearts and minds to be in this sacred space, I would ask us to think on this: In the Book of Ezekiel, God speaks to the prophet and commands him to "eat the scroll." (Ezekiel 3:3) In many translations of scripture, the descriptions get



pretty wild. The point the author was making is this simple, all the pretty works and ritual can only get us so far if we aren't taking in the Living Word of God. In our tradition we have greatly emphasized the centrality of the Eucharist, which at the heart is about joining word and sacrament. In this time of physical distancing, we are in a wonderful place to venerate the Word (those life giving words of scripture that give foundation to the symbols and elements of Bread and Wine).

I invite you, like the prophet of old, to "eat this scroll."
