- Design and construct your Pumpkin Race Car from a single real pumpkin. (Think: Pine Wood Derby Car)  
 Pumpkin Race Cars can be whole or carved; outrageously decorated, or just like you found it in the pumpkin patch.  
 Wheels must be directly attached to the pumpkin and operate on axels. Wheels can be of any type or size,  
**but the MAXIMUM TOTAL WIDTH for a Pumpkin Race Car including wheels CANNOT EXCEED 18" WIDE.**
- Pumpkin Race Car CANNOT be attached to anything that creates a chassis of any kind; such as skateboard, stroller, wagons, toys...etc. Wheels must be directly attached to the pumpkin.
- Pumpkin Race Car must be **POWERED BY GRAVITY ALONE**. No fans, motors, explosives or pushing.
- Pumpkins will race side by side. There is no penalty if pumpkins bump or collide with other pumpkins, track walls, etc.
- Pumpkin Race Cars will be inspected prior to race time to verify eligible entries.
- Divisions may be revised or created at the time of check in based on total number of participants, and at the Race Officials discretion.
- Special Prizes will be awarded for race winners, creatively decorated pumpkins, classroom spirit, group effort and more!
- Let your creativity go wild! If you don't win, at least you'll be racing in style!
- Race Officials have final say in eligibility and race results. Pumpkin Race Cars are run at the participant's own risk.  
 Saint Michael Parish assumes no responsibility for damage or loss to Pumpkin Race Cars during the event.
- Entries must be submitted to the Official's stand by 3:30 pm. 1<sup>st</sup> Heat to start @ approximately 4:30pm. Participants must submit a complete form and payment for each entry. A car representative must be present during the race.
