Upcoming W.O.W Events

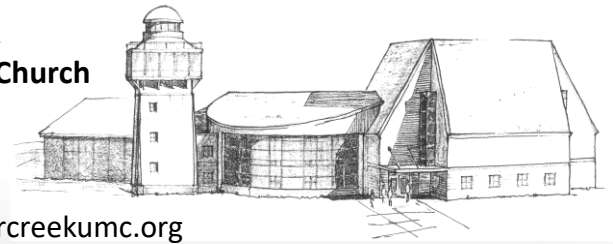
Women of Worship would like to remind you to make sure you save the date for their annual Chautauqua Women's Retreat which is taking place on May 30-June 1. More details to follow.
