SALEM IN THE CIVIL WAR

MARION COUNTY RESIDENTS RESPOND
TO ABE LINCOLN'S PLEA; FORM 111TH

Salem was a military town during the summer and autumn of 1862. Union forces had not, for the most part, been able to crush the Confederacy in what they had hoped to be a short war. While the men from Marion County had responded enthusiastically to President Lincoln's earlier calls for volunteers, his requisition for an additional 300,000 troops in July initiated the organization of the gallant One Hundred and Eleventh Volunteer Infantry Regiment which represented this area so heroically for the remainder of the War of Secession. Composed largely of Marion County citizens, the 111th was mustered at Salem and received their training there. A week by week account of their activities carried in the Advocate provides today's reader with the following diary:

- July 10 - Joseph F. BLACK and others of Salem are forming a company of volunteers in this county, in answer to the late call for more troops. Some thirty odd have enrolled.
- July 31 - Capt. BLACK left Salem with his company of forty odd men to rendezvous temporarily at Camp Centralia. Dr. ELDER of Fosterburg is currently raising a company, having received fifteen recruits on the first day.
- Aug 7 - Messrs. COVINGTON, ADAMS and MOORE are raising a company.
- Aug 14 - Amos A. CLARK and Kell RAINEY are recruiting. Joe SHULTZ is raising a company for Frank MARSHALL's regiment as are I.A. NORMAN and Howard BADOLLET. Middleton (now Iuka) has raised a full company with Joseph F. McGUIRE, W.B. EDDINGS, James B. YOUNG and L.W. COSTELLOW as officers. War meetings with patriotic speeches and music are being held.
- Aug 21 - The regiment forming in this county will rendezvous at the fair grounds in Salem. J.V. DAVENPORT and Joseph BENNETT received the contract for providing subsistence to the encampment. The companies under RAINEY, SHULTZ and McGUIRE are in camp. The little prairie of Red Lick in Marion County has furnished 25 recruits.
- Aug 28 - James S. MARTIN is in command of the 850 men of the 111th. Companies under BLACK, GRAY (Patoka), JOLIFF (Centralia), MYERS (Washington Co.), NICHOLS (Clinton Co.), and MAYBRY (Xenia) have all now arrived. Benjamin F. MARSHALL was named quartermaster, J.F. BLACK as Lieut. Col. and MAYBRY as Major.
- Sept 4 - A beautiful flag was presented to Capt. JOLIFF's company by the ladies of Seven Mile Prairie. The camp ground has been designated "Camp Marshall."
- Sept 11 - The 111th were out on their first parade, commanded by Col. Stephen G. HICKS of the 40th Ill. Vols. who is home recovering from wounds. This regiment presented a very fine appearance and was highly complimented by Col. HICKS for dexterity and accuracy. The men received their uniforms this week. (Footprints Editor's Note: Col. HICKS had been severely wounded in the Battle of Shiloh, April 6-7, 1862, while commanding the 40th Ill., and was home on recuperative leave.)
- Sept 18 - The regimental flag was presented to Col. MARTIN by the ladies of Salem. Following a dinner, served at the camp, the regiment, headed by the Salem Brass Band marched to a vacant lot north of the depot where, with music and speeches, the ceremony took place. Rev. J.B. WOOLARD was appointed regimental chaplain this week.
- Sept 25 - The Seventh Annual Marion County Fair was cancelled since the 111th was encamped at the fair grounds. Col. MARTIN was presented with a dress sword by Circuit Clerk Jacob O. CHANCE. Preaching and communion services held at the camp. The regiment received their muskets, blankets, shirts and drawers this week.
- Oct 2 - "The 111th is now ready for marching orders, excepting they have not been paid their bounty and advanced pay." The regiment was on its first dress parade this week and with their nice trim uniforms and glittering muskets presented a magnificent appearance.
- Oct 9 - The 111th were paid their bounty amounting to \$27 each. The Salem Band
