

Since we currently are not officially putting out a bulletin, I'm going to try and start sending out weekly e-mails again. We'll post them in the clubroom as well, for those that don't have access to an email account.

We're open Monday thru Saturday 10:00am – 10:00pm. We are following the Ohio Restaurant Promise Guidelines to keep our members safe. 6' foot distancing between chairs at bar, also between tables. We have tables set for 4, 5 or 6. No moving of tables or chairs please. We do have both ends of the bar designated as couples, where there are 2 chairs together. There is one service area to get your food/drinks ordered if you are not seated at the bar. Please use this, to sign up for drawings as well and keep that 6' safe distance in the line. I am very proud of our members who have been coming in and adhering to the rules as best they can. Currently Ohio is still under a Statewide Mask Requirement, therefore we ask all our members and their guests to wear a mask in and anytime you are moving around. While seated you do not need to wear the mask.

If we ask you to please not stand next to someone at the bar for any length of time or wear your mask, etc, please remember we are doing this for your safety and also the club's safety. If found in violation of any of the current COVID-19 rules, we could be fined and/or lose our licenses. We definitely don't want to be in that situation.

Reminder: *When you are in the Club, State Law requires you to have your **membership card** on your person. Not just your keycard. Please sign the back of your membership card in case we can't make out your signature on drawings. You will need to present your membership card to get any drawing winnings. Please understand, and be courteous, if you are ask to show your membership card at anytime. We do this to protect you and the club. If we are caught serving alcohol to non-members, our liquor license can be taken away and a large fine imposed! Thank you for your cooperation in this matter!*

MEMBERS MUST PAY FOR THEIR GUEST'S DRINKS PER OHIO STATE LAW!!! WHEN YOU LEAVE YOUR GUEST MUST LEAVE. *Also if you change your address, please help us keep our records current and mailing expenses down by notifying us.*

Guests shall be admitted to the premises of the Mansfield Liederkrantz not more than three (3) times a year and only if accompanied by a member of the Mansfield Liederkrantz.

HOUSE RULES

5. Only stewards, trustees and those appointed by the trustees are in charge of the management and conduct of the club rooms and others will not interfere with them.
6. Regulate your conduct in such a manner that others will seek and enjoy the club privileges
7. Be pleasant, courteous and sociable. Enjoy yourself wholeheartedly with imposing on others.
8. Respect the rights and privileges of fellow members.
9. Be fair and just.
10. Do not use your club membership for personal selfish gain, but try to make it beneficial for all of the members.
11. Any physical altercation by a member or guest will be dealt with harshly, possibly as much as a six month suspension from the club.
