- Smart phones/ tablets are not recommended due to the size of the screen. You need to see and be seen. Make sure the camera is at a distance to see face, hands, and signing area (chest/head).
- Please practice safety, ie. Do not attempt to drive or walk while engaged in a “zoom” session.
