



Details: The City of Painesville is accepting applications for the position of Water Operations / Maintenance Technician at the Water Treatment Plant.

Qualifications: Applicants must have a High School Diploma, or equivalent. A valid Ohio Driver's License; Valid Commercial Driver's License required within one year of appointment or at time of hire. Candidates for appointment to this position must obtain and maintain a Class I Ohio Water Operator certificate within three (3) years of appointment to this position, as issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. Must obtain and maintain an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency lab certification, as required, within one (1) year of appointment.

Work involves responsibility for the operation, maintenance, monitoring, sampling and control of water treatment plant and associated equipment on an assigned shift. Work includes responsibility for the adjustment of treatment processes to insure conformance with applicable water quality standards, maintenance of equipment and facilities, and preparation of operating records and reports. Employees will be required to work any combination of straight and rotational shift work as assigned including holidays and weekends.

Supervision: Work is performed with limited independence under the general supervision of the Chief Operator or Water Plant Supervisor, who will review work through conferences and reports for results obtained.

Physical Demands: Ability to lift at least 50 pounds of weight and work in confined spaces.
