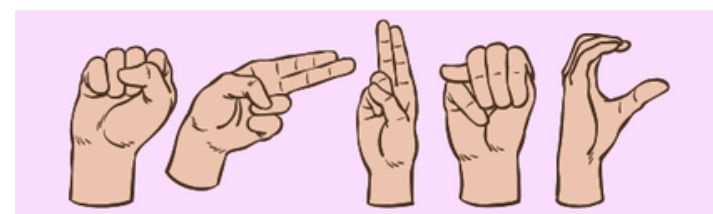
In our scripture lessons for this week we see Jesus and Paul doing just that. Paul is lifting up the Ephesian Church and praising them for their faith in Jesus Christ.

So let's be like Jesus and Paul and encourage and lift up each other in our faith journey with Jesus.

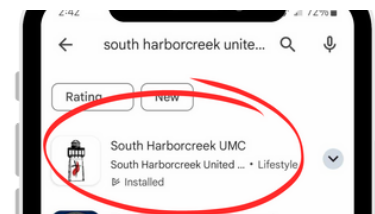
