How To Apply Online For Just Medicare

You can apply online for Medicare even if you are not ready to retire. Use our online application to sign up for Medicare. It takes less than 10 minutes. In most cases, once your application is submitted electronically, you're done. There are no forms to sign and usually no documentation is required. Social Security will process your application and contact you if we need more information. Otherwise, you'll receive your Medicare card in the mail. Learn more about your Medicare card.



Follow the directions and proceed. You want to make sure that Part A AND Part B will become effective on the 1st of the month you want your Medicare coverage to begin. (Generally, this is the same as your birth month or when you switch from an employer insurance company.)

- 6. Make sure to write down the reference/application ID number that they assign you during this process so you can return to the application at a later date if need be. You can also print the completed application if you have the capability
- 7. You are now asked to create a myssa.gov account prior to continuing to the application. This process requires security questions that many people do not remember. If this is the case you must at least try but can then continue to the application and set up the account later.
