## WEEKLY THOUGHTS 6<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME FEB 15<sup>th</sup> 2026

Dear friends, welcome to the celebration of the 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary time and Day of the Lord before the Lenten Season of 2026. Last Sunday, we mediated on the call of Jesus teaching his disciples; “You are the salt of the earth, you are the light of the world.” It is Jesus’ invitation to discipleship- being people of influence and shine holiness and truthfulness.

The first Reading of this Sunday Sirach 15:15-20 the author advises his son to choose wisely. It is a call to choose God. It is a call to choose good rather than evil. In all this choice, one must choose responsibly and freely – without any cohesion or fear. No one is given a license to sin or do evil.

In the Gospel Reading Matthew 5:17-37 Jesus continues to teach his disciples on the sermon of the mountain. Jesus reminds his listeners of the duty to love one another and neighbor- by doing away with any form of selfishness in the world that worship money, pleasure and honors. Indeed, Jesus gives love as a new commandment to all called to be his disciples.

Jesus again emphasizes Reconciliation among his disciples as a condition to prayer. “If you are at prayer and recall anger and hate against your brother, leave your gift at the altar – go first, be reconciled, pay him his due first and be reconciled- or apologize, then come back and offer your gift.” Hence love and charity are more important than prayer. St John maintains; “If anyone says I love God, but hates his brother, he is a liar.”

Jesus goes on to teach the sin of murder whose root cause is anger. Let us think of people whose reputation has been ruined by posts on social media! Jesus elaborates on the sin of adultery committed in the heart- the very center of all troubles. Recently Jesus taught that evil thoughts and intentions come from the heart other than from the food one eats.

Let us be guardian of our mouths- what we say that may be for the building up of the body of Christ- other than destroying or harming it.

Jesus invites each one individually to take effort and action to uproot all forms of corruption distancing us from Jesus and neighbor.

Let us seek reconciliation and avoid making false and selfish accusations.

Let us live humbly and respectfully with other people.
