

## Sexual sins identified    comments by lcl

### Bestiality

**Exo 22:19** Anyone lying with an animal shall surely be put to death.

**Lev 18:23** And you shall not lie with any animal to defile yourself with it. And a woman shall not stand before an animal to lie down to it. It is a perversion.

**Lev 20:15** And if a man lies with an animal, he shall surely be put to death. And you shall kill the animal.

**Lev 20:16** And if a woman goes up to any animal and lies down with it, you shall kill the woman and the animal. They shall surely be put to death; their blood *shall be* on them.

**Deu 27:21** Cursed is he who lies with any kind of animal. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Today, these punishments would not be approved by man's law, however, it should be sufficient to know that God judges this harshly and does not approve.

### Homosexuality

**Gen 19:1** And there came two angels to Sodom at evening. And Lot sat in the gate of Sodom. And Lot rose up to meet them when he saw *them*. And he bowed himself with his face toward the ground,

**Gen 19:2** and said, Behold now, my lords, please turn into your servant's house and stay all night, and wash your feet, and *you shall* rise up early and go your way. And they said, No, but we will stay in the street.

**Gen 19:3** But he urgently pressed on them, and they turned in to him and entered into his house. And he made them a feast, and baked unleavened bread, and they ate.

**Gen 19:4** But before they lay down, the men of the city, the men of Sodom, surrounded the house, both old and young, all the people from every quarter.

**Gen 19:5** And they called to Lot, and said to him, Where are the men which came in to you this night? Bring them out to us, that we may know them.

**Gen 19:6** And Lot went out to the door to them, and shut the door after him.

**Gen 19:7** And he said, I pray you, brothers, do not act evilly.

**Gen 19:8** Behold now, I have two daughters which have not known man. I pray you, let me bring them out to you, and you do to them as you see fit. But do nothing to these men, for this is why they came under the shadow of my roof.

**Gen 19:9** And they said, Stand back! And they said, This one came in to stay, and must he judge always? Now we will deal worse with you than with them. And they pressed hard upon the man, Lot, and came near to breaking the door.

**Gen 19:10** But the men put out their hands and brought Lot into the house to them, and shut the door.

**Gen 19:11** And they smote the men that *were* at the door of the house with blindness, both small and great, so that they wearied themselves to find the door.

**Gen 19:12** And the men said to Lot, Have you anyone here besides yourself? Bring your sons-in-law, and your sons, and your daughters, and whatever *you have* in the city, bring *them* out of this place.

**Gen 19:13** For we will destroy this place because great is the cry of them before the face of Jehovah. And Jehovah has sent us to destroy it.

**Lev 18:21** And you shall not let any of your seed pass through *the fire* to Molech, neither shall you profane the name of your God. I *am* Jehovah.

**Lev 18:22** You shall not lie with mankind as with womankind. It is abomination to God.  
**Lev 20:13** If a man also lies with mankind, as he lies with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination. They shall surely be put to death. Their blood shall be on them.

**Act 15:29** that you abstain from meats offered to idols, and *from* blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication; from which, if you keep yourselves, you shall do well. Be prospered.

**Rom 1:26** For this cause, God gave them up to dishonorable affections. For even their women changed the natural use into that which is against nature.

**Rom 1:27** And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust toward one another; males with males working out shameful, and receiving in themselves the recompense which was fitting for their error.

**1Co 5:1** On the whole it is reported *that there is* fornication among you, and such fornication as is not even named among the nations, so as one to have *his* father's wife.

**1Co 5:2** And you are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, so that he who has done this deed may be taken from your midst.

**1Co 5:3** For as being absent in body but present in spirit, I indeed have judged already *as though I were* present *concerning* him who worked out this thing;

**1Co 5:4** in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are gathered together, with my spirit; also, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ;

**1Co 5:5** to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

**1Co 5:9** I wrote to you in the letter not to associate intimately with fornicators;

**1Co 5:10** yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with idolaters; for then you must go out of the world.

**1Co 5:11** But now I have written to you not to associate intimately, if any man called a brother *and is* either a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such a one not to eat.

**1Co 6:9** Do you not know that the unrighteous shall not inherit *the* kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor abusers, nor homosexuals,

**1Co 6:10** nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit *the* kingdom of God.

**1Co 6:11** And such were some of you. But you are washed, but you are sanctified, but you are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

**1Co 10:8** Nor let us commit fornication, as some of them fornicated, and twenty-three thousand fell in one day.

**1Co 10:13** No temptation has taken you but *what is* common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted above what you are able, but with the temptation also will make a way to escape, so that you may be able to bear *it*.

**Gal 5:19** Now the works of the flesh are clearly revealed, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lustfulness,

**Eph 5:3** For let fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness not be once named among you, as becomes saints,

**1Th 4:3** For this is the will of God, your sanctification, for you to abstain from fornication,

1Th 4:4 each one of you to know how to possess his vessel (the body) in sanctification and honor

1Th 4:5 (not in the passion of lust, even as the nations who do not know God),

1Th 4:6 not to go beyond and defraud his brother in this matter (because the Lord *is the* avenger concerning all these, as we also have forewarned you and testified).

1Th 4:7 For God has not called us to uncleanness, but in sanctification.

1Ti 1:8 But we know that the law *is* good if a man uses it lawfully,

1Ti 1:9 knowing this, that the law *is* not made for a righteous one, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,

1Ti 1:10 for fornicators, for homosexuals, for slave-traders, for liars, for perjurers, and anything else that is contrary to sound doctrine,

1Pe 4:1 Therefore, Christ having suffered for us in *the* flesh, also you arm yourselves *with* the same thought, that he suffering in *the* flesh has been made to rest from sin,

1Pe 4:2 in order no longer to *live* in *the* lusts of men, but in *the* will of God the remaining time in *the* flesh.

1Pe 4:3 For the time of life which is past is enough for us to have worked out the will of the nations, having gone on in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, parties, carousings, and abominable idolatries.

Rev 2:14 But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the teachings of Balaam, who taught Balak to cast a stumbling-block before the sons of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit fornication.

Rev 2:15 So you also have those who hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.

Rev 2:16 Repent! But if not I will come to you quickly, and will fight with them by the sword of My mouth.

Rev 2:20 But I have a few things against you because you allow that woman Jezebel to teach, she saying herself *to be* a prophetess, and to cause My servants to go astray, and to commit fornication, and to eat idol-sacrifices.

Rev 2:21 And I gave her time that she might repent of her fornication, and she did not repent.

Rev 2:22 Behold, I am throwing her into a bed, and those who commit adultery with her into great affliction, unless they repent of their deeds.

Rev 2:23 And I will kill her children with death. And all the churches will know that I am He who searches the reins and hearts, and I will give to every one of you according to your works.

## Incest

Lev 18:6 None of you shall approach to any who are near of kin to him, to uncover *their* nakedness. I *am* Jehovah.

Lev 18:7 You shall not uncover the nakedness of your father or the nakedness of your mother. She *is* your mother; you shall not uncover her nakedness.

Lev 18:8 You shall not uncover the nakedness of your father's wife. It *is* your father's nakedness.

Lev 18:9 You shall not uncover the nakedness of your sister, the daughter of your father or the daughter of your mother, born at home or born away. Their nakedness you shall not uncover.

Lev 18:10 The nakedness of your son's daughter, or of your daughter's daughter, you shall not uncover their nakedness. For theirs *is* your own nakedness.

**Lev 18:11** You shall not uncover the nakedness of the daughter of your father's wife, begotten of your father. She *is* your sister.

**Lev 18:12** You shall not uncover the nakedness of your father's sister. She *is* your father's near kinswoman.

**Lev 18:13** You shall not uncover the nakedness of your mother's sister. For she *is* your mother's near kinswoman.

**Lev 18:14** You shall not uncover the nakedness of your father's brother. You shall not approach his wife. She *is* your aunt.

**Lev 18:15** You shall not uncover the nakedness of your daughter-in-law. She *is* your son's wife. You shall not uncover her nakedness.

**Lev 18:16** You shall not uncover the nakedness of your brother's wife. It *is* your brother's nakedness.

**Lev 18:17** You shall not uncover the nakedness of a woman and her daughter, neither shall you undertake to uncover her son's daughter, or her daughter's daughter. They *are* her near kinswomen; it *is* wickedness.

**Lev 18:18** And you shall not take a wife to her sister, to vex *her*, to uncover her nakedness, beside the other in her life.

**Lev 20:11** And the man who lies with his father's wife has uncovered his father's nakedness. Both of them shall surely be put to death. Their blood shall be on them.

**Lev 20:12** And if a man lies with his daughter-in-law, both of them shall surely be put to death. They have performed a perversion; their blood *shall be* on them.

**Lev 20:17** And if a man shall take his sister, his father's daughter, or his mother's daughter, and see her nakedness, and she see his nakedness, it *is* a wicked thing. And they shall be cut off in the sight of their people. He has uncovered his sister's nakedness; he shall bear his iniquity.

**Deu 22:30** A man shall not take his father's wife, nor uncover his father's skirt.

**Deu 27:22** Cursed *is* he who lies with his sister, the daughter of his father or the daughter of his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen.

**Deu 27:23** Cursed *is* he who lies with his mother-in-law. And all the people shall say, Amen.

**Eze 22:11** And a man has done abomination with his neighbor's wife; and a man has defiled his daughter-in-law in unchaste acts; and a man has humbled within you his sister, his father's daughter.

## Premarital sex

**Deu 22:13** If any man takes a wife and goes in to her, and hates her,

**Deu 22:14** and makes shameful charges against her, and brings up an evil name on her, and says, I took this woman, and when I came to her, I did not find in her the tokens of virginity,

**Deu 22:15** then shall the father of the girl, and her mother, take and bring tokens of the girl's virginity to the elders of the city in the gate.

**Deu 22:16** And the girl's father shall say to the elders, I gave my daughter to this man to wife, and he hates her.

**Deu 22:17** And, lo, he has made shameful charges *against her*, saying, I have not found in your daughter the tokens of virginity. And yet these are the tokens of my daughter's virginity. And they shall spread the cloth before the elders of the city.

**Deu 22:18** And the elders of that city shall take that man and punish him.

**Deu 22:19** And they shall fine him a hundred *shekels* of silver\*, and give them to the father of the girl, because he has brought an evil name on a virgin of Israel. And she shall be his wife. He may not put her away all his days.

**Deu 22:20** But if this thing is true and tokens of virginity are not found for the girl,  
**Deu 22:21** then they shall bring the girl out to the door of her father's house, and the men of her city shall stone her with stones so that she dies, because she has done foolishness in Israel to play the harlot in her father's house. So you shall put evil away from among you.

**Deu 22:23** If a girl *who is* a virgin is engaged to a husband, and a man finds her in the city and lies with her,

**Deu 22:24** then you shall bring them both out to the gate of that city, and you shall stone them with stones that they die; the girl because she did not cry out in the city, and the man because he has humbled his neighbor's wife. So you shall put away evil from among you.

**1Co 7:9** But if they do not have self-control, let them marry; for it is better to marry than to burn.

\* From internet research, 30 shekels would directly calculate at \$12,000 to \$15,000 in today's value when the shekel weighed approximately 0.5 ounces and silver prices today are around \$40 per ounce. This would yield a value of approximately \$600 at today's price of silver. That being established, read on.

There is always difficulty in trying to bring the values of the ancient world into today's terms. The relative value of goods and services today are entirely different than the relative value of goods and services of past times. For purposes of the valuation of the 30 shekels, The simple equivalent of the number of days of wages such would represent. A working person in biblical times could earn 30 shekels in about 4 months. Thus, if we want to figure what the value of 30 shekels would be to a person in biblical times, we would note that it was far more valuable to that person than what \$600 would be to us today. Today, a working person would earn approximately \$12,000 to \$15,000 during that same period. I believe this is an appropriate way of looking at the relative value of the shekels. Thus, 100 shekels would be as much as \$50,000 today.

## Prostitution

**Lev 21:9** And the daughter of any priest, if she profanes herself by going whoring, she profanes her father. She shall be burned with fire.

**Deu 23:17** There shall be no harlot of the daughters of Israel, nor a sodomite of the sons of Israel.

**Deu 23:18** You shall not bring the hire of a harlot, or the price of a dog, into the house of Jehovah your God for any vow. For even both these *are* hateful to Jehovah your God.

**1Co 6:15** Do you not know that your bodies are the members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make *them* the members of a harlot? Let it not be!

**1Co 6:16** Or do you not know that he being joined to a harlot is one body? For He says, The two shall be one flesh.

## Rape

**Deu 22:25** But if a man finds an engaged girl in the field, and the man forces her and lies with her, then only the man that lay with her shall die.

**Deu 22:26** But you shall do nothing to the girl. No sin *worthy* of death is in the girl; for as when a man rises against his neighbor and slays him, even so is this matter.

**Deu 22:27** For he found her in the field, the engaged girl cried out, but *there was* none to save her.

**Deu 22:28** If a man finds a girl, a virgin not engaged, and lays hold on her, and lies with her, and they are found,

**Deu 22:29** then the man who lay with her shall give to the girl's father fifty *shekels* of silver, and she shall be his wife. Because he has humbled her, he may not put her away all his days.

Knowing that all the above is severely disapproved by God, why would anyone put so much potential jeopardy on their possibility of horrible eternal rewards? Some say they were created this way, but I assure you that this would not have been God's plan. It directly would contradict His laws.

Allow me to offer another possibility. Given that all of us need fellowship and love to feel complete, it is likely that we will adjust our thinkings to rationalize most anything, especially, if we do not look to God for our primary guidance!

People are influenced by the environment about them to shape their views of who they are and who they want to interact with. If they had poor experiences with specific genders as infants or children, they would be inclined to seek alternate caring persons to receive love from as an adult. Very poor self images also become important results of being abused as a child. That is why it is so important for caring and loving parents to bring up children so they are mentally whole and can seek love and acceptance as God intended. Damaged spiritual bonds must be broken by prayer and much help. All things are possible through Christ though. I would hope that anyone in need would seek help before it is too late.
