



March 2nd, 2021 Zoom Meeting Call

Treasurer's report of \$10,783.69 in the bank. Groomer repairs last month were slightly over \$10,000.00, groomer is now fully functional and ready for use.

Mark reported on the groomer stats to date:

Used 66 hours in January. With 614 gallons of fuel at \$2.27/gallon

Used 117 hours in February. With 740 Gallons of fuel at \$2.55/gallon.

Fuel usage and labor total \$8,196.56 to date. This is about halfway thru the budget amount for the year. We plan on being able to groom until mid-April if the conditions warrant grooming.

A vote on the name change of the Snow Club was conducted via email with current members. Of the 35 members 20 responded, with the majority voting for "**North Routt Snow Riders**". Work will be completed to affect the name change over the next few months.
