ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday, November 24^{th,} 2021, 7:00 PM (MST) OR WHEN LIMITS HAVE BEEN REACHED at the address of the Trial Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or changed, except for as provided in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the AKC Obedience Regulations. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to November 24th, 7:00 PM. A wait list of 5 entries will be kept for each trial.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. A written request (email notification is acceptable with return email receipt verification from the secretary) to withdraw from competition must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than 24 hours prior to the start of judging. The Club will refund the entry fee, less a \$10 processing fee, unless the spot can be filled by someone on the wait list.

Entries will be refunded if the show is canceled due to COVID-19.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor or shredded. Please make sure we can read your entry! Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3). Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners TM Program should be listed as All-American Dogs and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. A recording fee of 50 cents per first entry of each dog and Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry is required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only Ch. 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules.

-The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.

-Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries specifying any condition as to acceptance cannot be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, telephone, fax or email entries will not be accepted.

-The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.

-Entries will receive an email confirmation within 7 days after receipt if an email address is provided on the entry form, otherwise, the confirmation will be sent via USPS standard mail. If acknowledgments are not received by an exhibitor 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.

-Consult Judging Schedule for time of judging.

-Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

-The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.

-The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss or injury.

-Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.

-There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial grounds or premises.

-In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.

-Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, or if it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the Trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

-MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trials judging.

Rules for entering this trial:

- 1. NO overnight parking.
- 2. NO smoking allowed on the grounds.
- 3. You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle idling in the parking area.
- 4. Collars must be in accordance with AKC Board Policy, July 2001 (No Electronic Collars)
- 5. There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial grounds or premises
- 6. Crating: Outdoors on grass. Pop-ups allowed. Wire/metal crates are encouraged for safety and ventilation. Mesh crate must be completely zipped closed while dog is inside.
- 7. Dogs that escape from crate or are uncontrolled must be removed from the show site.
- 8. Please keep dogs quiet. If barking cannot be controlled, you will be asked to leave.
- 9. Keep dogs on leash while not exhibiting.
- 10. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.


