Robert M. McKee, age 84 of Dallas, Texas (formerly of Port Austin and Lake Placid, Florida) passed away Sunday, February 2 at Presbyterian Hospital in Dallas.

He was born on May 9, 1912 in Saginaw, the son of the late William D. and Mayme (Smith) McKee. On March 4, 1939 he was united in marriage to Ruth Eileen Rapson in Saginaw. She preceded him in death on August 5, 1991.

A bus driver with the Greyhound Bus Company, Mr. McKee retired in 1974 after working with the company for 31 years. Before his retirement, he was the financial secretary for Local 1303 A.F.L.C.I.O. Greyhound Bus Drivers Union.

He was a past member of the Elks Lodge in Lake Placid, and while he and his wife Ruth lived in Pt. Austin, they were members of First United Methodist Church, Pigeon.
