A Guide for Selecting Proper Equipment BOWS

If the beginner in Archery is to experience the progress which makes for lasting interest and maximum enjoyment of the Sport, he must begin with properly fitted equipment. Skilled and accurate shooting is dependent upon the consistency with which each successive arrow is shot. Consistency is dependent upon the degree of accuracy with which arrows are matched in weight and spine (stiffness) and upon the accuracy with which arrows are fletched (feathered). For consistent shooting it is also very essential that the pounds of force or thrust behind each arrow be exactly the same. The "pounds of pull" of a bow is an expression of the pulling force required to draw that bow (pull the bowstring back) to a fixed distance. If the thrust behind each arrow is to be consistent, it will be readily understood that the distance the bow is drawn must be the same for each shot. In Archery the arrow is the gauge which regulates this pulling distance.

To correctly measure the arrow length most suitable for you, place the nock of an arrow in the center of your chest about six inches below the chin. Hold the point end between the palms of your hands. With the arms extended to their full reach, straight in front of you, the point of the arrow should extend to the tips of your fingers. (See Fig. 2). This is the proper method of equipping the archer with target arrows.

For selecting proper length arrows of other types refer to Fig. 1. Select each type of arrow so that the tips of the fingers extend to that point on the arrows indicated by the dotted line.

By all means be sure that you shoot the correct length arrows because the development of real skill depends on this



Now - whether you anchor under your

chin (generally preferred by target archers using bowsights) or with the first finger at the corner of your mouth (for instinctive shooting and hunting) - you have a gauge to regulate your pulling distance. When shooting target arrows

you will know that you have reached full draw for each shot when the point is flush with the back of the bow (the bow surface farthest from the eye). Hunting and field arrows will extend from the back of the bow but, when you have the proper length, a part of the instinctive skill quickly developed will enable you to easily gauge the full draw point.

In choosing any bow do not make the mistake of becoming "over-bowed". Choose one that you can pull to full draw and hold without shaking or straining too much and you will be able to develop proper shooting habits and progress more rapidly than if your bow is too heavy for you. A little tremor or shaking is all right; the muscles used for drawing a bow will develop quite rapidly with routine practice. But, in shooting, it is best to lay the bow down for a while if it becomes difficult to draw and hold for precise aim. It is easy to develop bad shooting habits and you always want to avoid "snap" shooting.

For many beginners, school archery programs and for budget minded bowhunters the YORK line of solid fiber glass bows offers a complete selection of styles and lengths. Review the specifications on these and note that the various models are available at different maximum pulling weights and that each is "weighed" at a certain draw distance. Choose from these, keeping in mind that each is designed for specific applications. Thus, the very young boy or girl will want a 4 ft. bow while the high school or college age beginner will prefer the SG-50 or SG-54 in the 20 to 30 pound range. The bowhunter will want a 45 to 55 pound bow.

To obtain the maximum enjoyment and pleasure from the Sport of Archery choose a YORK composite bow. Laminated of the finest fiber glass and woods the nature of their design and construction is such that these bows provide the highest degree of limb efficiency and shooting smoothness.

Generally speaking, bows 64 inches or longer are best for any phase of the sport involving continuous shooting. However, those archers who shoot 26 inch arrows or less will want to give serious consideration to bows 64 inches or shorter to take full advantage of the limb efficiency built into their bow. The bowhunter will place a high value on the shorter bows for maximum cast and easier handling in the brush.

Your composite bow is precision built and deserves fine care. When not in use keep it unstrung and hung vertically or on a bow rack with pegs supporting both limbs. Apply a coat of good furniture wax occasionally to protect the finish. Be very careful while bracing (stringing) your bow to avoid twisting the

Recommended brace heights are given for each bow as an approximation in the catalog specifications. This distance is measured from the bowstring to the deepest cut in the handle, sometimes called the pivot point. See Fig. 3. Proper brace height for each model will vary with different archers and shooting styles and should be adjusted, by twisting the bowstring, to obtain maximum freedom from string noise.






