How do I cast my vote?

EFRW mails a voting proxy to all the members of the system. You may attend the meeting and turn in your proxy and ballot, or if you are unable to attend, you may complete the proxy by appointing someone that will be attending to cast your vote then returning the Proxy and ballot to EFRW's office on or before October 16, 2024. These proxies will be given to the appointee at the annual meeting for the purpose of casting your vote.

Getting Ready for Winter

Fall is the perfect time to start your winter preparations! Homeowners should protect pipes in attics and crawl spaces with insulation. Outside pipes should be drained or insulated in 2" fiber sleeves. Outside faucets should be covered or wrapped in old towels or newspaper. Water hoses should be drained, disconnected from outside faucets and put away for the winter.

It's a good idea to leave your heat set no lower than 55 degrees.

If you are going out of town, it's always a good idea to turn your water service off at the meter and

drain your service lines and indoor plumbing to ensure you don't come home to water damage.

Generally, if you've winterized your home then you typically do not need to drip your faucets. If you do drip your faucet, then a stream of water the size of a pencil lead is more than enough.

In order to maintain water service during weather events, EFRW needs the public's help by managing their dripping faucets, inspecting their service lines, and valving out water leaks as soon as possible. If you see a problem, be a good neighbor and get it reported to EFRW. By working together, we can keep the water flowing!

Coming In October: Service Line Inventory

EPA revisions to the Lead & Copper Rule now require all community water systems to submit a Service Line Inventory to the Louisiana Department of Health. EFRW will have this Service Line Inventory available on our Website by the October 16th deadline. Please be sure to followup at www.eastfelicianaruralwater.com for all the up-to-date information.

HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

Ahead of a potential storm, EFRW is inspecting well sites to ensure sites are clean and clear of any debris that poses a threat to the site. Generators are inspected and fueled up in case of power outages. Chlorination systems are inspected, and cylinders changed out in order to manage proper disinfectant in case of lengthy outages.

During a storm Operations personnel are monitoring SCADA systems to ensure wells, pumps, and towers are functioning as designed and that pressures are being maintained.

After the storm has passed Operations personnel inspect well sites for damage and address any issues such as leaks due to lightning strikes, downed trees and powerlines.

The Office of Homeland Security recommends that residents be prepared with at least 3 days of food and water. This will allow time for Disaster Relief teams to access the area and determine the needs of the public.
