A Little Bit of Information About Neveln

A First through Fourth Grade Elementary School

Demographics:

- 50.9% White
- 39.1% Hispanic
- 6.3% Asian
- 3.7% Black
- 64% of our Students qualify for Free/Reduced Lunches
- 24.3% of our Students are identified as English Learners
- 14.6% of our Students receive Special Education Services.

Neveln Provides Students with Quality Educational Opportunities, including:

- 120 minutes of reading instruction
- 90 minutes math instruction
- 30 minutes of Gym 3 days a week
- 30 minutes of Music 3 days a week
- 40 minutes of Art 1 day a week
- 30 minutes of recess/lunch daily
- Gifted and Talented Instruction
- Reading and Math Interventionists
- Computers in every classroom

Parent Involvement:

- We have a very active PTC that funds many of our special events, awards and teacher requests.
- We have monthly Hispanic Parent meetings.

At Neveln, Character Counts!!

- Each month we have a Character Counts assembly where we honor one student from each classroom who exemplifies one of the six Pillars of Good Character.
- During the month students earn I-Can cards from adults for acts of good character. There cards are entered into a random drawing. At our monthly assembly one student's name is drawn from each grade and those four students get to have a pizza party with the principal.
- We have weekly Golden Awards where classrooms are given awards for their students' behavior during building activities like staying quiet in the hall, keeping the lunch room clean and behavior at recess.
- At our end of the year awards assembly, one student per grade is chosen as the Character Counts Student of the Year and honored at the assembly.

Total Enrollment and Staffing:

- 346 Students: 92 in 1st grade, 90 in second, 88 in third and 76 in fourth
- 15 Classroom Teachers
- 27 teachers total
- Including 2 special education teachers, 2 EL teachers, 3 interventionists, 1 instructional coach and 2 Reading Corps interventionists
