Course Introduction:

The course addresses all aspects of the healthcare laundry cleaning profession, in particular, the importance of proper techniques and practices to reduce the risk of infection to workers and patients. The course includes recommendations by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), Center for Disease Control (CDC) Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JACHO). Upon completion, Students will have a clear understanding of the importance of their role in the Healthcare laundry work environment.

- Lockout & Tagout Procedures
