

**TOWN OF CLOVERDALE
ORDINANCE 1996-8**

**AN ORDINANCE PROMOTING
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM**

WHEREAS, the I.C. 36-7-2 authorizes cities and towns to promote economic development and tourism; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of such activities the Town is authorized to budget and appropriate funds from the general fund for such expenses.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Cloverdale as follows:

That the Town of Cloverdale be authorized to budget and appropriate funds from the general fund of the city, or town, to pay the expenses of or to reimburse city officials or town officials as the case may be for expenses incurred in promoting the best interest of the city or town. Such expenses may include, but not necessarily be limited to rental of meeting places, meals, decorations, memorabilia, awards, expenses incurred in interviewing job applicants, expenses incurred in promoting industrial, commercial, and residential development, expenses incurred in developing relations with other units of government and any other expenses of a civic or governmental nature deemed by the Town Board of Cloverdale to be in the interest to the Town.

This Ordinance shall have full force and effect upon passage of the Cloverdale Town Board.
