Meeting of the DeKalb County Commission  
DeKalb County Road & Bridge Building, Maysville, MO

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed Courthouse Staff and elected Officials as they joined us for the opening prayer led by Kyle Carroll. The pledge was then said by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the agenda as presented with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Attending today's meeting was Mark Murphy.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen advised he had attended the Extension Meeting March 1<sup>st</sup> where County Clerk, Melissa Meek swore in new members.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White advised he had attended the Tri-County Health meeting on Friday the 26<sup>th</sup>.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll and West District Commissioner, Kyle White attended the Washington Township meeting that was held on February 25.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll attended the meeting of the DeKalb Daviess Regional Jail on Friday February 26.

Bids were discussed for mowers for the County. More bids will be obtained.

The ramp into the hallway in the basement was discussed and the need to revamp it.

At 9:30 bids were opened for the mowing of the cemeteries. Bids were received from Mark Murphy and Rogers Outdoor services. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to accept the bids from Rogers Outdoor for the 3 cemeteries which include Schuckman, Smith and Old Maysville. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second. All in favor. Carroll, aye, White aye and Owen aye. Motion carried.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented documents concerning the BRO project, time sheets and reminded them of the NW Commissioner's Meeting to be held the 18<sup>th</sup> of March as well as the NW Clerk's meeting to be held the 19<sup>th</sup> of March.

At 10 a.m. bids were opened for the removal of 3 trees on the Courthouse lawn. Bids were received from Bob Dorton and Mark Murphy. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen makes the motion to accept the bid from Bob Dorton Tree Service. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the second. All in favor. Carroll-aye, White- aye and Owen-aye. Motion carried.

At 10:30 bids for rock were opened with the following in attendance. Mark Robinson and Gerald Utt of Grand River Township, Larry McFee of McFee Trucking, Mike Traeger of Traeger Limestone and Jim Knox of Norris Quarries. After reviewing bids from Traeger, Norris and McFee, West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to accept the low bid from Norris Quarries for sales tax rock.

After much discussion concerning all other rock West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to take all bids concerning FOB from Norris Quarries with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor, Carroll-aye, White-aye and Owen-aye. Motion carried. Be it noted that Norris Quarries was not the low bidder on FOB but due to their presence in the County and the time it took to go to Traeger the best bid for all other rock is Norris Quarries. County Clerk, Melissa Meek will notify Norris in their acceptance of bid letter of specific instructions on sales tax rock.

At 11:30 bids were opened for Trash Disposal. Bids were obtained from R & W Disposal and Waste Management. After much discussion East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the motion to accept the bid from R & W with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. All in favor, Carroll-aye, White-aye and Owen-aye. Motion carried. The bid to R & W includes the County purchasing their own dumpster with R & W disposing of the waste weekly and as needed.

After consideration the DeKalb County Commission passed the Resolution for The Second Amendment Preservation Act.

The final bids were presented for the building at road & bridge to house equipment for the new tower that is being erected for 911. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to accept the bid from A2Z Construction with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor, Carroll-aye, White-aye and Owen-aye. Motion carried.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission to discuss equipment, roads brush and equipment needing sold. It was determined to sell equipment thru Big Iron due to employees within our County.

Kevin Bell of Foley Equipment met with the Commission to discuss bids on equipment they sell. He will get figures together and meet back with the Commission. It was noted that Foley doesn't do State Bids.

The Commission approved Country Harvest having their annual Easter egg hunt on the Courthouse Lawn.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn with Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.
