

# Every Group Should Have in addition to 15 patrollers, 4 instructors (minimum) -

- Dispatch Instructor
- IC Instructor
- Triage Instructor
- Extrication/Treatment Instructor

## SIMPLE INCIDENT COMMAND REVIEW:

- 1. Establish Command
  - a. WHO First On Scene then Most Competent
  - b. When Immediately upon arrival at the scene
  - c. Where Give exact location of incident.
  - d. What Advise Base/PHQ that ICS has been established & Location of Command Post.
- 1A. Assign a MEDICAL BRANCH DIRECTOR
- 1B. Assign an EXTRICATION BRANCH DIRECTOR.
- 2. Assign a TRIAGE SUPERVISOR.
- 3. Assign a TREATMENT SUPERVISOR.
- 4. Assign a TRANSPORT SUPERVISOR.
- 5. Assign a SAFETY OFFICER = Can be anywhere during set up of Command Structure.



**INCIDENT COMMAND POSITIONS** 

**INCIDENT COMMAND - Establish Command** 

WHO – FIRST ON SCENE

Then: Most qualified

<u>Safety Officer – Reports DIRECTLY to IC. Can stop the event if unsafe actions and ask for more source planning.</u>

<u>MEDICAL Branch Director – Manages ALL MEDICAL including; Triage, Treatment & Transport. Give direct</u> orders to the three "T's".

<u>EXTRICATION Branch Director – Manages all Extrication & difficult patient movement. This person can be a "worker-bee". This person will be assigned to manage lift evac if people still trapped on lift or work with Transportation.</u>

<u>Triage Supervisor – Does the INITIAL TRIAGE using ribbons or ASSIGNS a person to this task. Call immediately with color of patients as triaged. Most Important job: Manages Triage.</u>

<u>Treatment Supervisor – Immediately SETS UP the Treatment Areas. Is responsible for tagging ALL patients with TRIAGE TAGS. Will work directly with Transport for patient removal.</u>

<u>Transport Supervisor – Assists in moving triaged patient into the treatment area. Then moving tagged</u>
patient from Treatment to where EMS is located. Responsible for quick assessment of equipment needed.

<u>Logistics – Works under TRANSPORT Supervisor. IMPORTANT JOB – Management of all equipment needed</u> for the incident.

Comm's Person/IC Aid – Assists IC with Planning or monitoring second medical frequency.

### MCI TRIAGE (START)

Standard techniques of first impression, primary survey, & secondary survey take TOO MUCH TIME. START Plan (Simple Triage and Rapid Treatment):

- 1) Identify the "Walking wounded".
- 2) NEW -STOP THE BLEED
- 2) Assessment and basic care of ventilation.
- 3) Assessment and basic care of circulation.
- 4) Assessment of mental status.
