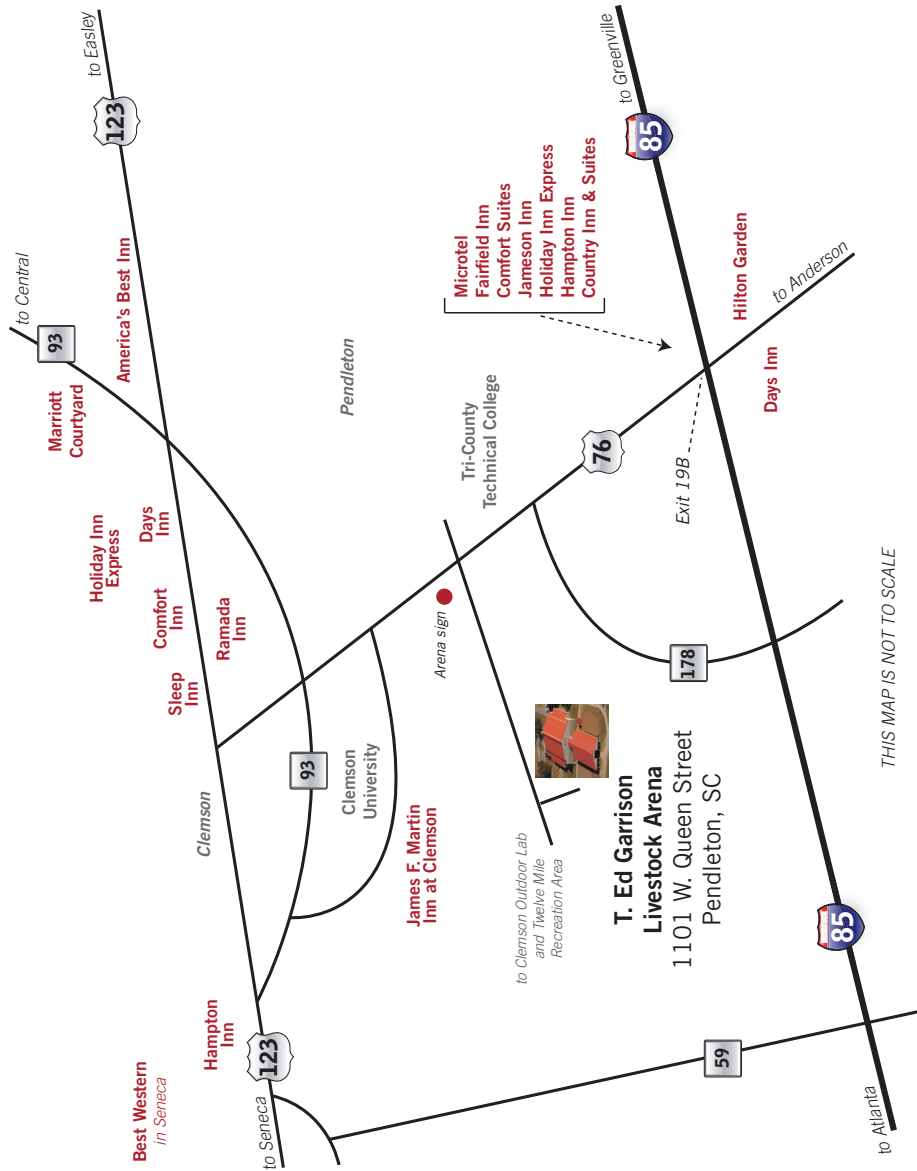

2026 Membership Application American Saddlebred Association of the Carolinas

The following membership categories are more fully defined in the ASAC Bylaws, Article III, Section 1. Memberships are for the calendar year, January 1 thru December 31.

- (A) Lifetime: Lifetime members must be at least 18 years old. They have all the rights and privileges of a Senior Member.
- (B) Senior: Individuals who are 18 years old or older as of Dec. 1, 2025. Senior Members shall be entitled to vote in person or by proxy on each matter submitted to a vote of members.
- (C) Junior: Individuals who are 17 years and under as of Dec. 1, 2025. They may attend all membership meetings but have no voting power. They may take part in all junior programs sponsored by ASAC.
- (D) Affiliate: Any person or business that wishes to support and be associated with ASAC, but has no voting power and is not eligible to participate in ASAC's High Points program.

Above members of the Association (with exception of Affiliate Members) shall be either residents of North or South Carolina or shall breed, raise, board or exhibit one or more American Saddlebred Horse/ Hackney Pony/Roadster Horse, or participate in a lesson program, with a trainer/instructor who is an active ASAC member. **Must be a paid member 15 days prior to any called membership meeting to be eligible to vote at said meeting.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

- 1. ENTRIES:** Entries must be postmarked by March 27, 2026 to avoid late penalty. Entries will not be accepted over the telephone. All entries must be made on the Official Entry Blank and must be signed with complete address and phone number. A post entry fee of \$15.00 per horse will be charged if postmarked after March 27, 2026. All entries will be charged a non-refundable OFFICE FEE OF \$20.00 PER HORSE. Horses or ponies not entered in a class when entries are submitted will be considered as a post entry.
- 2. REGISTRATION PAPERS:** A PHOTOSTAT COPY OF REGISTRATION PAPERS SHOWING CURRENT OWNERSHIP MUST ACCOMPANY EACH HORSE ENTERED in the American Saddlebred, Hackney Pony, Roadster Horse and Friesian Divisions. WE MUST KEEP A COPY ON FILE IN THE SHOW OFFICE. Numbers will not be released for an entry in these divisions without proper proof of registration.
- 3. CLASS ENTRIES:** Class entries may be made up to (1) hour before the scheduled start of each session. Emergency entries may be made after that time at the regular entry fee plus an emergency fee of \$15.00 per class. Failure to scratch an entry from a class (1) hour before session will result in forfeiture of entry fee.
- 4. STABLING:** Stalls will be available on April 6, 2026 at 8am (not before). Early arrivals may be granted if stalls are ready and arrangements have been made with management to move in early. The early arrival fee will be \$40 per stall per day. NO STALL will be reserved unless payment in full accompanies request. Stall fees are \$150.00 each. All stalls are equipped with doors and are of large size. ALL NON-STABLED HORSES will be charged a grounds fee of \$40.00 per horse.
- 5. REFUNDS:** Refunds requested before March 27, 2026 will be made in full, less a \$20.00 scratch fee per horse and the non-refundable \$20.00 office fee. Refunds requested before the start of the show but after March 31, 2026 for entries must be accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate of illness or lameness on an official letterhead received by the Show Office before the end of the show. If the above criteria is met, fees will be refunded minus STALL FEES, a \$20.00 SCRATCH FEE per horse, \$20 non-refundable office fee per horse and any post entry fees paid. No request received after April 6, 2026 will be honored.
- 6. EMERGENCY REFUND POLICY:** In the event all or part of the competition is cancelled due to a storm, accident or other emergency. If the competition is cancelled prior to April 6, 2026, all fees including stall fees will be refunded in full minus the non-refundable office fee. Stall fees will not be refunded after April 6, 2026. If classes are cancelled once the competition has begun, entry fees for remaining classes will be refunded.
- 7. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** ALL HORSES MUST HAVE PROOF OF NEGATIVE COGGINS TEXT PERFORMED WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF THE SHOW
USEF GR 845
 1. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the property. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of the vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations, name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon requests by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

In addition all out of state horses are required to have a Health Certificate current within 30 days.
- 8. RESPONSIBILITY:** The Greenville Horse Show and Fair, Inc., The Greenville Horse Show Committee, The owner of the facility, The Horse Show Manager or any employee of the Horse Show shall in no way, jointly or individually, be responsible for loss, accident, damage or loss of life that may occur to any exhibitor, owner, trainer, agent, groom, stable, horse, corporation, partnership, individual or spectator sustained at the Greenville, S.C. Horse Show held in Clemson, S.C.
- 9. MANAGEMENT:** The Show shall be under absolute control of the Management. Only qualified persons shall be allowed in the ring during judging. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judge or Officials on the part of the owners, rider, groom will disqualify horse or rider and the owner shall forfeit his entry fees and other fees.
- 10. THE HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:**
 - a. Vary or add to the names of those officials who have been invited to participate.

- b. Cancel or combine any class with less than (4) entries.
 - c. Refuse any or all entries, return any money paid for stalls or entry fees without explanation or recourse to the show for liability or compensation.
 - d. Limit the number of horses accepted in each division
 - e. Require a minimum of a \$400 sponsorship for an added class.
 - f. Require every animal entered for competition to be under the control of the management.
- 11. BEDDING AND FEED:** NO INITIAL BEDDING WILL BE SUPPLIED AND STRAW WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. Initial bedding can be ordered on the entry blank. Additional bedding, hay and grain will be available and must be ordered through the Show Office and will be delivered the same day if ordered by Noon. Preordered shavings on entry blank will be available at stalls when you arrive. NO BULK BEDDING WILL BE ALLOWED.
 - 12. ATTENDANTS:** ALL ATTENDANTS ENTERING THE RING MUST BE PROPERLY ATTIRED.
 - 13. STRIPPING:** No classes will be stripped.
 - 14. VAN PARKING:** All vans and trailers must be parked in the designated area after unloading. Fire regulations prohibit parking in barn area.
 - 15. PRIZE MONEY:** Prize Money will be credited to the account of the agent listed on the entry blank. Prize money will be mailed within 30 days after the close of show. ALL CHECKS MUST BE CASHED WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER DATE ISSUED. Checks will become non-negotiable after 60 days.
 - 16. ACCOUNTS:** All accounts must be paid at the Horse Show Office before entry numbers will be given out. STALLS will not be reserved unless paid in full. Returned checks will be charged a return check fee of \$50.00. A SIGNED open check must be left in office prior to packets being distributed. An unsigned open check sent in with entries will be accepted as post entries. The Horse Show Office WILL NOT be open on Sunday following the show. Accounts must be settled before the last class of the Saturday evening performance. Anyone failing to settle their account will relinquish the right for adjustments. It will be to your advantage to check over your account before filling in your check.
 - 17. RESERVED SEATS AND TABLES:** These may be reserved in advance on entry blank. There will be six chairs at each table at a cost of \$500.00 for regular tables and \$700.00 for premium tables.
 - 18. CAMPER SPACES:** Available at \$50.00 per night. Any trailer plugged into an electrical outlet will be charged a camper fee. You must go to the show office as soon as you set up and get your permit to be placed in the window.
 - 19. HORSE SHOW OFFICE:** The Horse Show Office will be open beginning April 6, 2026 from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm each day prior to the show and at 9:00 am until after the last performance each day during the show. The Office will be closed (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of each performance for taking entries for that performance. The Show Office WILL NOT be open on Sunday following the horse show. Call (864) 630-1669 or (502) 314-7960 for information or website.
 - 20. IMPORTANT:**
 - a. HORSE SHOW OFFICE WILL CLOSE 1 HOUR PRIOR TO EACH SCHEDULED PERFORMANCE.
 - b. Exhibitors wishing to pay individually must complete a separate entry form designating the agent with all required information.
 - c. No stall will be assigned unless stall fees are paid. Stall fee is \$150.00 each. All stalls are under permanent roof with lots of electrical outlets, lights and water. The stalls that are placed in the Cattle building are large (10 x 10) and are well constructed with permanent doors.
 - d. All registration papers, measurement cards/copies, membership cards/copies, etc must be shown before entry packets will be issued. A copy of registration papers and coggins must be left on file in the show office and will not be returned.
 - e. All entry blanks must be filled out completely and signed with the proper signatures.
 - f. Footing in all rings consist of a dirt base and a mixture of sand and sawdust on top to give the surface a soft footing. The show arena is 265' X 135', the covered warm-up ring is 260' X 120' and the two outside warm-up rings are each 170' X 120'.
 - 21. PONIES:** Ponies will be measured at 8:30am Wednesday April 8, 2026, at the farrier station. Show management will announce other times for ponies to be measured.
 - 22. BUY A CLASS:** CLASSES 25, 46, 77 and 111 are designated BUY-A-CLASS classes. Trainers may request a BUY-A-CLASS classes for \$400 each. Requests will be accepted by show manager by email at dcsllc@charter.net beginning at 8am on Monday, March 4, 2026. First come; first served.
 - 23. PHOTOGRAPHY:** SCB Photography (Sarah Bennett Pearce) is the official photographer for the 2026 show. Any other photography, or advertisement thereof, taken of subjects within the confines of the show ring without prior written consent from show management is expressly forbidden. Violation of this rule will be grounds for removal from the premises.
 - 24. SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
 - 25. Credit Cards** may be used for payment of all fees; a 4% convenience fee will be charged.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

GR 1210.4- REGARDING SHARPS CONTAINERS

Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Competition management will place a notice of this requirement either in its prize list or on a specific handout given to trainers on check in at the competition. If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail. Competitions failing to comply with placing the required number of containers on the show grounds will be considered in violation of the rules and may be subject to penalty as determined by the CEO or Executive Director and/or the Hearing Committee.

DRIVER'S LICENSE STATEMENT (GR 1301.7)

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

AMERICAN SADDLEBRED DIVISION

All horses must be registered with the American Saddlebred Horse Association or the Canadian American Saddle Horse Registry. They must be entered in their full registered names with registration numbers and under the names of the owners of record. A copy of the registration papers or Certificate of Eligibility to show issued by the American Saddlebred Horse Association must be submitted with entry before competition number will be released. A copy of the CURRENT registration papers and coggins must be left on file in the show office and will not be returned. All owners, riders, drivers, handlers and trainers at US Equestrian recognized competitions in all Saddlebred sections must be current members in good standing with the American Saddlebred Horse Association, Inc. and must present a copy of their card with entries or sign an affidavit.

ATTENTION ACADEMY ENTRIES: CHANGES ARE TO BE MADE BY 5:00 PM ON FRIDAY TO AVOID A LATE PENALTY. ACADEMY ENTRIES ARE TO FOLLOW ALL OTHER ENTRY RULES. The purpose of this division is to introduce potential owners to the joys of showing horses and give riders the opportunity to gain experience in a full horse show atmosphere. The American Saddlebred Association of the Carolinas sanctions these classes. A complete copy of the rules and regulations governing these classes is available at the horse show office. Riders in this division are students who are enrolled in a professionally operated program and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. Riding suits are not allowed; jodhpur, boots, and pants are suggested. Safety helmets are the only acceptable headgear for academy riders and are required for ALL 10 & Under riders. Riders may not cross enter into any performance classes with the exception of driving classes and show rider classes. A rider who has shown in a regular division class or in a full riding suit is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division with the exception of the Academy Show Rider classes. Horses are to be lesson type horses. These horses must display the characteristics of such. No type of pad or rim pad will be allowed. A rider may show his/her horse as long as the horse is regularly used in a lesson program. If the horse is privately owned, the horse must be used for lessons and be shown by other riders per show than only for the said owners. Horses must not be in training. Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with martingale or a Pelham/full bridle. Blinkers not allowed in under saddle classes. Flat cutback English saddles are to be used. Hoof blacking is optional and ribbon braids are not allowed. Horses may cross enter into the performance and equitation division at all shows. Horses are not to be judged. If you have any questions about the ASAC Academy Rules please contact your UPHA Rep, UPHA Chapter Chair, or ASAC Academy Committee Chairs. Horses in violation of these rules will result in disqualification of all academy entries at this show from barn of horse in violation. While rules may be different in other states, horses from programs outside of the Carolinas must abide by these rules at ASAC sanctioned shows in North and South Carolina. Anyone not abiding by these rules or horses deemed to be a danger will be eliminated from competition by authority of the horse show management, UPHA Chapter 12 Representatives/Officers or ASAC Officers/Directors. ALL CLASS CHANGES MUST BE MADE BY 5:00 PM FRIDAY; CHANGES AFTER THIS TIME ARE SUBJECT TO A \$25.00 FINE PER CHANGE. 8 Ribbons.
