SPANISH VALLEY WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Regular meeting ----- August 19, 1992

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE George M. White at 7:00 P.M. at the District office. Other Board members present were Dan Holyoak, Neal Dalton and Paul Morris.

Others present were David Adkison, Robin Stewart, Elaine Matthews, Gary Wilson, James Walker, David Maki, Dale Pierson, Marsha Modine and Roberta R. Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of July MINUTES 15, 1992. After calling for additions or corrections, the Chair declared the the minutes be approved as read.

David Adkison passed the 1991 audit report to 1991 AUDIT those present, gave a summary, and asked for questions. Dan moved to accept the 1991 audit. Neal seconded MOTION CARRIED.

Robin Stewart asked for a reduction in her water STEWART WATER bill because a pressure peak caused her line to break, caus-BILL ing a higher than usual usage in June. Marsha printed her usage history, and the Stewart usage was discussed. Dan moved that \$15.00 be deducted from her bill. Neal seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Elaine Matthews asked if anyone had talked about WATER LEASE the proposed Agreement sent by Brent Rose, and asked if the AGREEMENT District was going to have the well drilled and make the application. The proposed agreement was discussed and Elaine stated she would contact Brent Rose regarding her understanding of the basis for the proposed agreement.

The proposed county master plan was discussed, and GRAND COUNTY Dale suggested the districts be named in the pertinent MASTER PLAN paragraphs and in the paragraphs regarding irrigation water. He also noted that the Moab Irrigation Company was not mentioned. He suggested the expansion of the sewage treatment plant and expansion of the culinary water lines up-valley should be included. David Maki stated he agreed with Dale, and also stated he felt there were redundancies within the documents that should be excised. Gary Wilson stated this draft was supported by the County Commissioners, and invited Maki to the public hearing to state that opinion there. After a discussion George suggested Dale's Comments be put in a letter from both boards, and sent to the County Commissioners.

Roberta reported that Harold Jones had come into JONES WATER the office to see if something could be done about his very BILL high bill for a leak that had occurred while he was gone.

After comparing Harold Jones water use with his last year's JONES WATER use, 56,000 gallons as a normal use was agreed upon. Dan BILL (Cont.) moved a reduction of \$10. for July and \$15.00 for August be given Mr. Jones. Neal seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Marsha passed the financial statement to those FINANCIAL present, and asked for questions. The statement was briefly STATEMENT discussed.
