The <b>Deadly Wound on Head #1</b> of Rev. 13 is <b>received</b> when Pagan Rome is conquered by Herulic King Odoacer in 476 AD. Romulus the boy (last) western Roman emperor, was sent into exile.	The False Prophet of Rev 19:20 and the Little Horn of Dan 7: 8 is the succession of Popes. The 2 horned beast of Rev 13:11-18 has horns like a lamb (biblical symbol for Christ) and speaks like a dragon (biblical symbol for satan). It has the appearance of a Christian church but satan is in its heart (see Matt.15:11 & Mark 7:15). The image of the beast is the church government with its civil & political horn and its religious horn made in the likeness of the Pagan Roman Govt. It speaks through its head mouthpiece, the pope with his words and papal bulls and causes the people of the world to worship the beast (Rev.13) and to take his symbolic mark or number (in numerology) of his name ( <b>ROMAN</b> or <b>LATEINOS</b> = 666) on their right hand ( <b>work &amp; worldly actions</b> ) or on their forehead ( <b>belief &amp; allegiance</b> ) or face persecution to death at the hand of the kings and their armies who give their allegiance to him. Revelation 13: 11-18 As before the beast (Rome) will require the mark of <b>Roman Catholic Sunday Worship</b> and doctrine only. The "Venerable Day of the Sun" was first proclaimed law by Constantine in 321 AD and later at the Church Council of Laodicea (364 AD) the church outlawed resting or Judazing on the Seventh Day Sabbath established by God.
