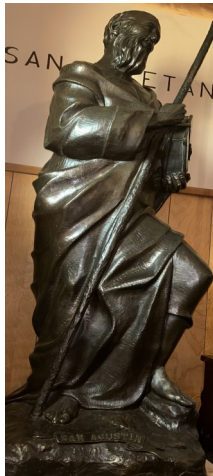


El Santuario de los Pobladores — Dedicated to the Mysteries of the Rosary



Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. The plaques will have a significant placement in the Santuario courtyard as you enter. This phase will begin in the spring of 2024.

This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine that has been moved to its permanent home at the Sanuario along with the Holy Family statue. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio. In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Santuario and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. MASS THEME

Theme: The Profession of Faith

Candidates for public office and their aides know that the more they are convinced of their beliefs, the greater their enthusiasm and the better their chances of winning. In campaigning they draw up posters that tell in a nutshell what they stand for. Slogans on badges and bumperstickers as well as "position papers" serve the same purpose. These formal statements of belief strengthen the identity of the group and show others what their party program is all about. Religion as organized into groups has its "Confessions of Faith." They are brief formal statements of what the collective faithful believe in. These confessions determine the identity of the group or church. They are pronounced at meetings repeatedly and they strengthen mutual belonging, which is so important in religion. Think of our Profession of Faith during our weekly worship services! Today's Liturgy deals with confessions of belief in both the Old and the New Testament. Prayerful reading may help us to profess our faith wherever we are.

BIBLICAL COMMENTARY

FIRST READING Dt 26:4-10

[Confession of Faith]

This reading is a "Eucharistic Confession," a confession of thanksgiving. It is taken from the ritual prescribed for the feast of the harvest thanks-giving. "My father was a wandering Aramean.." Jacob (Israel), perpetually seeking pasture for his flock, ended up in Egypt where his clan first enjoyed prosperity and later was enslaved. Notice that the Exodus from Egypt "with terrifying power, with signs and wonders," has for the Jews a meaning similar to what the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ means to us Christians. Both are mighty acts of God resulting in liberation. Both inspire a Confession of Faith in which these mighty acts are recited. "Say to the Lord, 'My refuge and fortress, my God in whom I trust'" (Responsorial Psalm).

SECOND READING Rom 10:8-13

[Creed of Christians]

This reading contains a baptismal Confession: "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord,... you will be saved." Our Confession of Faith at baptism is now more elaborate, but the very core of it is that God has raised the Lord Jesus Christ from the dead and made him Lord. Pay special attention to your Profession of Faith during this worship service!

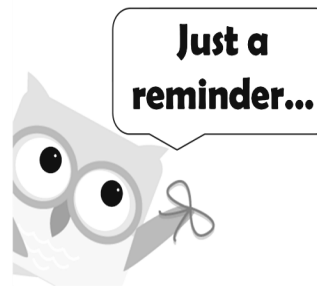

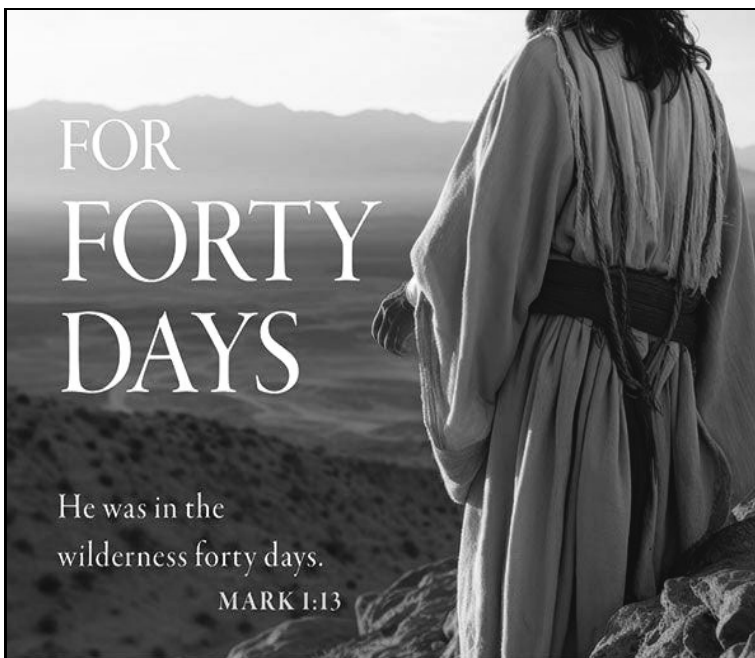

Question of the Week

During this Jubilee Year of Hope, what or who sustains me in hope through periods of trial?



He was in the wilderness forty days.
MARK 1:13

The forty-day season of Lent represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry. We use this time in a similar fashion—engaging in spiritual reflection in quiet places, resisting the devil’s ploys and getting our hearts ready to spread the news of Christ’s suffering, death and resurrection for our salvation.

QUIET MOMENTS In our noisy, busy culture, we are often afraid to simply sit in silence. But Lent calls us to be quiet in order to pray to Jesus and listen for his voice telling us which way to go in our lives of faith. Jesus set aside forty days for quiet reflection in the wilderness, and he gives us the strength to do the same.

RESIST THE DEVIL The devil “prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour” (1 Peter 5:8). But we don’t have to be afraid. We have the Word of God at our disposal to defend ourselves against the devil’s lies, and we have the knowledge that Jesus never fell for any of the devil’s temptations. Lent reminds us that Jesus has the power to not only resist but defeat the devil by dying on the cross as the sinless Son of God for our sake.
