**Youth Swine Department**

Duroc – Must be Red with droopy ears, and show no white spots or markings. Black spots must be no larger than a quarter.

Hampshire – Must be black with solid white belt encircling the front legs and shoulders. Must have erect ears. Any variation of belt will be considered by the board. White back legs are only to the hock.

Yorkshire – Must be all white with erect ears. No spots or freckles on animal.



**Division – Breeding Swine**

Division Rules:

- Registered & Grade Animals Can Enter
- No swine over 1 year of age will be allowed in the tent area or show in the ring, they will be housed in separate pens and judged from the pens
