Current Water Restrictions



Austin is currently under **Stage 2 drought restrictions**, and that includes Coronado Hills. Here's what you need to know:

Watering Schedule for Residential:

Hose-end sprinklers:

- Odd-numbered addresses – Saturday
- Even-numbered addresses – Sunday
- Only allowed before 10 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

Automatic irrigation systems:

- Odd-numbered addresses – Wednesday
- Even-numbered addresses – Thursday
- Only allowed before 5 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

Drip irrigation:

- Odd-numbered addresses – Wednesday & Saturday
- Even-numbered addresses – Sunday & Thursday
- Only allowed before 5 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

Watering Schedule for Multi-Family:

Hose-end sprinklers:

- Odd-numbered addresses – Friday
- Even-numbered addresses – Tuesday
- Only allowed before 10 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

Automatic irrigation systems:

- Odd-numbered addresses – Friday
- Even-numbered addresses – Tuesday
- Only allowed before 5 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

Drip irrigation:

- All addresses – Tuesday & Friday
- Only allowed before 5 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

We encourage neighbors to go a step further and reduce any non-essential water use. Every gallon we save now helps protect our aquifers, support native wildlife, and ensure there's enough water for all—especially as we face longer dry seasons. Small changes at home = big impact for the community. Let's conserve together.

**** What Happens If We Don't Follow the Restrictions? ****

The City of Austin enforces drought restrictions. Repeat or willful violations can result in fines starting at \$75 and increasing with each offense. Reports of water waste can be made through 3-1-1.

Let's all do our part to avoid penalties and keep our community water-smart!

This month we're recognizing Anna Grimes for her dedication to keeping Coronado Hills safe and heard. Thanks to Anna's ongoing communication with the Code Department, the recurring illegal dumping at the dead end of Glenhill and Berkman stayed on their radar — and because of her persistence, that location was chosen for **a new surveillance camera as part of a citywide effort to get a handle on dumping.**

Austin City Council recently allocated \$463,000 for illegal dumping enforcement, and our neighborhood was selected because Anna kept pushing for action.

Anna is continuing a legacy built by other neighbors, including the late Ileta Lawrence, who lived near the site and regularly organized clean-ups and brought in support from groups like Keep Austin Beautiful.
