## RULES

1. This is a handicap tournament consisting of a 2-member team.
2. Tournament format. 6 Baker games will be bowled at Butler Bowl, 6 Scotch doubles games will be bowled at Garrett Bowl, and 3 regular games per person will be bowled at Auburn Bowl. Total pins for all 18 games will determine a winner.
3. This is a handicap tournament consisting of a 2-member team.
4. All entrants must be sanctioned by the USBC. Bowlers must have a current membership card when checking into bowl. All bowlers must have bowled at least 21 games this season by January 1, 2025.
5. Each bowler must be at least 18 years old and one team member must be at least 21 years old.
6. **AVERAGES:** Averages for determining handicaps shall be as follows: The highest USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the immediate preceding season (Yearbook) winter, summer or \*Sport or Challenge. \*Sport, Challenge, or Collegiate averages must be adjusted using the Sport or Challenge Bowling Average Adjustment Chart. If current average of 21 games or more as of one week prior to participation in the tournament is 10 or more pins above the preceding Season (Yearbook) (winter, summer or \*Sport) average, that current average must be used. If participant has no average for the preceding season (Yearbook) winter, summer or \*Sport or Challenge, current average of 21 games or more as of one week prior to participation in the tournament must be used. All others shall bowl from scratch (210). Verification of average must be presented at time of bowling. **USBC RULE 319 C & D WILL APPLY TO THIS TOURNAMENT AND ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE SUBJECT TO RE-RATING.** All bowlers **MUST** report any average re-ratings, accepted or not accepted. No tournament prize winnings need be reported. Additional rules pertaining to averages will be forwarded with confirmations.
7. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the team average and 440.
8. Tournament prize winnings provision rule 319d applies.
9. Bowlers must be listed on the entry form in the order in which they will bowl. There will be no changes in the order of bowling once the entry is submitted. If a substitute is required, the sub shall take the place of the original entrant in the line up. Substitutes must meet all tournament eligibility requirements.
10. Prize fund will be returned 100% with a prize ratio of at least 1 in 5.
11. Bowlers will check in one half hour before scheduled squad time. Any bowler arriving after tournament play has started will receive zero for all frames missed.
12. USBC rules will be observed. The tournament manager will decide any other questions. The tournament manager's decision shall be final unless an appeal is made in writing within 3 days.
13. Baker game format. Bowler 1 Will bowl frames 1,3,5,7,9 and bowler 2 will bowl frames 2,4,6,8,10 for games 1, 3 and 5. Bowler 1 will bowl frames 2,4,6,8,10 and bowler 2 will bowl frames 1,3,5,7,9 for games 2, 4 and 6.
14. Scotch Double format. Every ball will be alternated between bowler 1 and 2. If bowler 1 throws a strike then bowler 2 will bowl the first ball the next frame. If bowler 1 does not strike then bowler 2 will throw at the spare then bowler 1 will throw the first ball the next frame. If bowler 2 throws a strike then bowler 1 will bowl the first ball the next frame. If bowler 2 does not strike then bowler 1 will throw at the spare then bowler 2 will throw the first ball the next frame. Bowler 1 will start game 1, 3 and 5 and bowler 2 will start games 2, 4 & 6.
15. The last 3 games will be normal games. Each bowler will bowl 3 games each.
