The TBLA Board — The Board met on August 15th. Representatives from La Wildlife and Fisheries presented two grant requests which will be considered and voted on at the next board meeting on September 19. One of the requests was to fund an artificial fish attractor for the Cypress Bend Park fishing pier and the other is for funding a scholarship for a fisheries doctoral candidate. The Board agreed to sell 2017 Bass Unlimited Back a Great Fighter tee shirts, hats, visors, and towels at the October Monthly social and also voted to move the November Board of Directors meeting up one week to Wednesday, November 16th.

<u>Toledo Bend Lunker Bass Program</u> — We currently have eight Lunkers in the 2017-2018 Lunker Bass Program. The weather remains hot and the lake water surface temperature on some days is in the high eighties to low nineties. As I stated last month, a large fish caught in these hot months will typically not survive an extended stay in a live well nor tolerate any mishandling. Please take care of your fish and release them as soon as possible.

Please respect the fact that the lake still has thousands of these stumps which are no longer visible at 171-172 but will be very evident as the lake falls.
