The adjudication will be based on a 5-Star System and students will receive thorough, educational, informative, meaningful and constructive feedback. 5 Stars will be awarded to an outstanding performance that exemplifies thorough preparation. Subsequent stars will be based on areas needing improvement. A cumulative stars program is in effect and awards will be given at various star levels.

Time limit: 8 minutes consisting of no more than 2 pieces

Photocopying of music is prohibited

1 Copy of the music must be present when the student performs
