Position Opening Wastewater Attendant/Operator I

The City of Wilmington, Ohio is announcing an open competitive exam to establish an Eligibility List for the position of Wastewater Attendant/Operator I. The written test will take place at 10 a.m. on April 8, 2020 in the Community Room located in the Wilmington Municipal Building, 69 N. South Street, Wilmington, Ohio. Applicants will not be admitted after the examination begins. The scope of the written exam will be multiple-choice questions relative to qualification requirements.

Requirements/Qualifications:

- High School diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Must be able to obtain an Ohio EPA wastewater Operator I license within the first two years of employment.
- Must be mechanically inclined. This position will include a large amount of maintenance-related work, in addition to operator tasks.
- Must be able to learn and follow requirements of working in EPA certified lab
- Ability to work a varied schedule which will require some weekends.

Starting base salary will be consistent with the City's approved pay plan; Wastewater Attendant: \$16.62; Wastewater Operator I: \$19.24. Prior relevant experience will be considered when determining salary. Each pay plan has established annual salary step increases.
