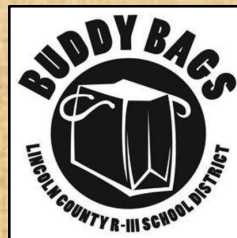
Buddy Bags provides extra food for students & families who need a little help on the weekends.

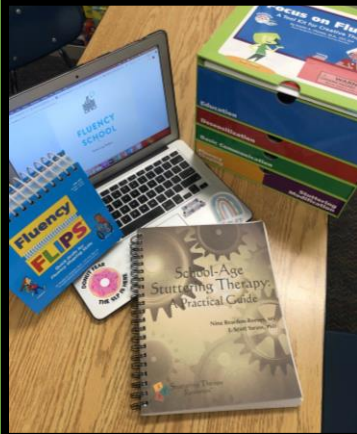
