The Audition will include Ballet, Jazz, Lyrical/Contemporary, Tap and Hip-Hop Audition combinations will be taken from those learned at Summer Intensive

The dancers that are chosen for Blankenship & Company, will be put into dance repertoire as decided by director Susan Blankenship. During your audition there will be an interview. Dancers should be prepared to express what they will bring to the company (particular skills, work ethic, leadership, etc.) and what their commitment level will be. Dancers will also be asked the dance styles and number of dances they would like to participate in. The interview is an important part of the process. It is the Director's choice, if chosen to be a member of the company, which style of dance you will be performing.

Please do not audition if you are not positive that you want to participate and not devoted to the extra time commitments required to be a Company Dancer. Please do not audition just for fun.

If you are chosen as a soloist, you will directly pay your choreographer for your private each week.

All dancers need to bring big smiles, girls' hair in buns, looking your best, wearing leotards and tights. Please bring **ALL** your dance shoes to audition!

## All Company Dancers are required to take the following classes during the 2021-22 Dance Season

  - 2 Ballet Classes,1 Lyrical / Contemporary class, Progressive Ballet Technique with balls and Jumps & Turns weekly
- Jazz Company
  - 1 Jazz Class, 1 Ballet Class weekly and Jumps & Turns weekly
- Tap Company
  - 1 Tap Class weekly, 1 Ballet Class weekly
- Hip Hop Company
  - 1 Hip Hop class weekly

All Company Dancers are required to regularly attend their scheduled dance classes and Company Rehearsals!

## What are the expenses of being a company dancer

Competitions/Conventions plus traveling expense: Hotel / Food

Entry Fees approximately:

Solos \$110.00 each Duet/Trios \$60.00 each

Groups \$ 50.00 each

Costumes: Approximately \$100.00 each & purchasing Dance shoes & Tights

Teacher Traveling Fees: \$25.00 per dancer for each competition

Music editing Fees \$15.00 / Dance

Choreography Fees \$50 solos, \$25.00 duos, trios, groups (each member) paid to SPAC and forwarded to the Choreographer

Rehearsals for dances are added into your monthly tuition. A rehearsal is charged the same as additional class time.

## Who is the Director of The Blankenship & Company Dancers?

### How does a dancer become a Blankenship & Company member?

To be a Blankenship & Company Dancer you must attend the annual closed audition. Your past class work ethic and attendance are taken into consideration. All decisions are final. Parents please do not call the director or teachers to discuss audition results.

## Are there any rules for a Blankenship & Company Dancer?

Blankenship & Company Dancers are not allowed to dance with any other **STUDIO** performing group, or take classes at another studio.

Dancers are required to participate in Company productions, competitions, workshops, conventions, company performances, weekly rehearsals, and required classes.

Dancers are asked to **notify the studio and <u>give reason</u>** for any daily absences. If you are sick and not contagious please attend, sit and watch your rehearsal and classes. When you have conflicts that arise, please put them <u>in writing</u> and give to **Susan Blankenship.** 

A company member that abuses company policy and does not take responsibilities seriously **will be dropped** from the Company.

As an extracurricular activity, dancers are expected to make Blankenship & Company their <u>FIRST</u> priority. Outside activities can be worked around within reason. Please do not expect teachers to accept numerous missed rehearsals and classes due to conflicting schedules. Company dancers must be committed to the work as well as the fun and work as a team.

#### **COMMUNICATION SOLVES CONFLICT!**

We do want our students to take advantage of all performance opportunities. Please make sure that any individual performances using company material that you may choose to do on your own go through Susan Blankenship. In other words, you must have permission to perform company material on your own.

Each company member is assigned a locker. Dancer provides their own lock.

All Blankenship & Company Dancers information is delivered through Band. We have a separate Band group for Company Dancers only. It is the students and parents' responsibility to keep this information organized.
