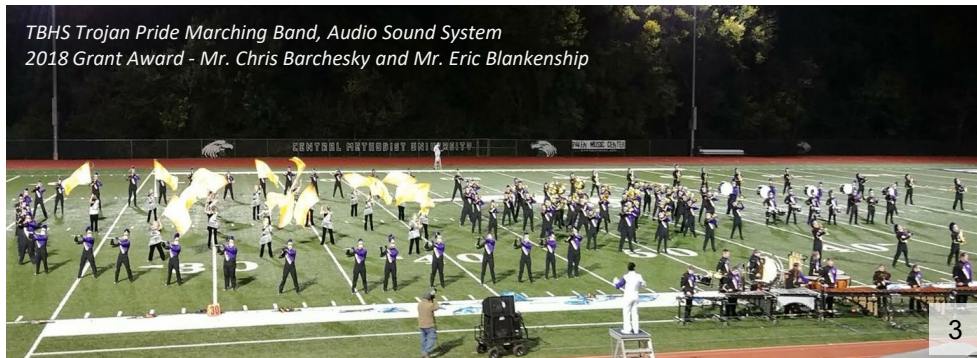

# The LCR3EF Annual Grant Program



Through community philanthropy, we support education excellence in the Lincoln County R-III School District by funding projects and programs not otherwise possible within the constraints of the District's annual operating budget. District staff submit grant requests in February in the areas of student enrichment, instructional initiatives, or early childhood education. A committee evaluates the application against the District's strategic plan and a point scoring system. Grants are awarded in May each year, and implemented the following school year.

# 2018 Grant Program Results

# 2018 Grant Program Results

Speech and Language Therapy iPads with large storage and current apps have enabled a 4-fold increase in the use of apps and a 2-fold increase in the use of iPads for instruction; adding more options for therapy techniques. Exciting results included student ownership of their growth and self-evaluation with video feedback; and increased communication choices for non-verbal students. Pathologists were able to increase their effectiveness and provide more one-on-one attention.

# LCR3EF Partner: Buddy Bags



Buddy Bags provides extra food for students & families who need a little help on the weekends.

- Currently 380 students are fed each weekend. (PreK – High School)
- Each bag contains enough food for 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, and 2 snacks.
- Each child's weekly bag of food costs approximately \$5.50.
- Larger bags are sent home on long weekends or extended breaks.
- Donations of food & cash are used to fill these needs.
- Volunteer students assemble the bags during Early Release Wednesdays.

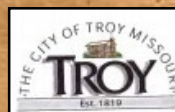
