DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing recurve. This is a man's bow. It has a beautiful massive Brazilian Rosewood riser that takes the shock out of the shot. I found it to be smooth and accurate. Desert tan back limbs, and black face limbs. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 3 filled screw holes (2 on the side of the riser and one on the face) - see pics). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in excellent condition. Were it not for the 3 screw holes, this bow would be in near mint condition.

Herter's is noted for odd sizes and string lengths. The specs note it is an AMO 60" bow and takes a 53.5 inch string (actual length). When I shot the bow, a AMO 60" string was too long, but a an AMO 58" string fit well.
