



1500+ people put their trust in Christ! And 5 churches were planted!



Laston is the man who is appointed as National Director of e3 in Malawi. He's a wonderful man who has followed the e3 model closely and has a vision for its impact in the country. On trips in the past we have had problems with other National Directors but we were so blessed to work with Laston. He shared with us his hopes and goals for his country, "We have been praying that God would send missionaries to come help us plant churches. There are so many churches here that want to begin new churches and they need the training and the help. God set up this campaign with Tom and Kathy and a team of 9. And I asked God, 'Please, we have so many more pastors, could you send more missionaries!' Mike Tally, another E3 church planter, had a delayed campaign due to unforeseen visa problems in Mozambique so they came to Malawi! Now we have had two campaigns in 3 weeks and many many churches

were planted, almost all the pastors in Mulanje have been trained and God has answered our prayers way above and beyond what we expected!"

"There is a white person here who wants to talk with you!" We come to a village and our church member disappears. We wait patiently and people with chairs on their heads start to appear. People from all over start to come from the tea field, the corn, the clay baked homes and from behind trees! The next thing you know you are sitting in a chair surrounded by 15 -20 people all sitting on the dirt ground in front of you! You begin to share your testimony and the evangcube and lead all 15-20 people to Christ! It makes you realize that this message you have just shared is precious. You became 'bait' and the Master Fisherman has caught His fish.



"We are so excited you are here. Now you can assist us in planting churches in neighborhoods that need Jesus!" Proverbs 4:18 "But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, which shines brighter and brighter until full day." Teaching and training, discipling, and evangelizing the lost- its the path of the righteous. This work we have been engaged in and we have seen it come to full light- the fruit of it can be seen. 30 men gather around to hear the message of salvation and receive the free gift of God. After lunch one of those men run down to meet Kathy, his face beaming with JOY! "You got to come to my house!" We go to an area of 5 houses belonging to the village beer distributor. the man says, "My family has to hear this message, its changed my life and they have have to hear it too!" As the gospel is shared, the man eagerly looks to see the expressions on his family's faces. He is expecting to see excitement and joy light up their faces. After the prayer, he takes our hands and says, "we are not going to be selling beer anymore." An hour before this encounter, we had prayed over this area, that the stronghold of alcohol would be broken.



Tom led Gerard and his wife to the Lord. He asked them what this message meant to them. His answer, "Im saved, I know I have eternal life! I really want to tell others about this!" (*selah- pause and think about that!) Tom told him how he could share with other people

and asked him if he could do some discipleship with him the next day. Both happened. During the discipleship Gerard was so excited to learn and grow in his understanding of salvation. He wanted to go door-to-door with Tom the next day and share the “good news.” So the next day he was ready to go. He was able to share his testimony and help his neighbors meet Jesus the way he had!

17 of them! We are bumping along the unpaved roads, maneuvering around the pot holes and around tea fields. 15 minutes later we are standing in front of 17 Malawians! They are starting to collect near us because they heard the van. As we find out later, there are no vehicles in these villages and a car coming out this far is rare. Its even more strange and unusual to see a white guy and girl being dropped off and left there! So Christy and Justin get out the training materials and begin to share. Going through the gospel with the E-cube we are aware that 90% of them have never heard it nor have they had the opportunity to give their lives to Christ! Once the invitation is over 90% of them raise their hands to accept Christ as their Savior. We come to realize there is no church here, this is the beginnings of the church this very moment. The people that we led to the Lord, that day, became the new church. These people were faithful to go out with us every day and were eager to grow in their new faith. They reminded us of the first disciples that followed Jesus. It was so thrilling!



We went into an area near a Jehovah Witness Hall. The people were very skeptical and said, “How do we know you are not ‘false prophets?’ I told them that we would only share what the Word of God says. They asked all sorts of questions, then wanted to know about a dream that one of them had. It sounded horrible- demonic. They had been having strange demonic happenings in heir home. So, we gathered around the house, prayed over it, dedicating the house, everything in it, and their children to the Lord. After we were done, a large group of people had gathered asking to be prayed over. Many people were healed and started praising God with loud rejoicing. Soon the whole village had gathered, and surrounded us, everyone wanting prayer. Realizing I needed to lead a Bible study several villages away, I promised to come back the next day. The next day 85 people prayed for salvation. God had used miracles to confirm His message and break the bonds that the false cult of Jehovah’s Witnesses had over the village. Praise God for “releasing the captives” Satan had held in bondage for years!




