A physical survey showed little signs of rotten wood. Repair will be as needed, then the whole fence will be painted. Quotes will be revisited with this in mind.



<u>Water Pipes</u>: Looks like we avoided any mishaps from the freezing weather! And the great news is that the sustained freezing temperatures should temper the mosquito population when it gets warm again! Hurray!

<u>Irrigation:</u> New landscaping needs irrigation to establish new plants. Once established, irrigation can be reduced for perennial plantings, especially as weather cools. Unnecessary irrigation was turned off to perennials so that we are not <u>needlessly</u> paying.

Electricity: All thermostats have been set at the same temperature in each building. Repairs and replacement needs were also noted

<u>Pond/Wells:</u> 1) Due to the low water level, the fountains were pulled out. This prevents them sinking into the mud which can break them. 2) Our new landscape contractor has gotten the center pond shallow well running and will be working on the shallow well in front of B building in early January. 3) The deep well is not operational and we continue to seek an appropriate well company.
