Lawn Parking NOT OK

The City of Austin has a NO PARKING ON LAWNS ordinance. The governing city ordinance is 12-5-29, City traffic ordinances, and is enforced by APD. A person may not park a motor vehicle in the front yard or side yard of a residential property, except in a driveway, or a paved parking space depicted on a City of Austin approved site plan.

This pertains to both OPERABLE AND NON-OPERABLE motor vehicles. Motorized vehicles include automobiles, motorcycles, trucks, vans, motor homes, panel trucks, buses, and sport utility vehicles. ■
