Ordinance No. 2005-56 Amendment

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Marion, in the County of Centre and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereby ordains:

Original Ordinance, No. 2005-56, Section VII A. is replaced with the following:

VII.A. Each person owning a building served by onlot sewage disposal system, which contains a septic tank, shall have the septic tank pumped by a qualified pumper/hauler within the earlier of six years from the effective date of this Ordinance or the last pumping (last pumping that can be verified by the Township Sewage Enforcement Officer). Thereafter, that person shall have the tank pumped at least every six years or whenever an inspection reveals that the septic tank is filled with solids or with scum in excess of 1/3 of the liquid depth of the tank. Receipts from the pumper/hauler shall be submitted to the Township within the prescribed periods with a report of any system problems noted.

The remainder of Ordinance 2005-56 is reaffirmed in its entirety.
