


# Paradise Valley Park is located on west side of 40<sup>th</sup> Street between Bell Road and Union Hills Road in Phoenix, AZ.

# AKC CODE OF SPORTSMANSHIP

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

## **Notice to Exhibitors**

This show is held under American Kennel Club rules.

## ENTRIES

Fees must accompany entries. The Club and/or Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form or for a dog being entered in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for the entering of the same dog twice.

All entry changes must be submitted in writing to the Trial Secretary before closing.

The Obedience and Rally Trial Committee may decline any entry for cause or may remove any dog on account of sickness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or cause against the Club or an official thereof. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of an entry prior to closing of entries.

Bitches in season are ineligible to complete in trials. To receive a refund for a bitch in season entry, a written notice from the exhibitor stating the bitch is in season and is being withdrawn, must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. There will be a \$2.00 processing fee charged for each entry from which the bitch in season is withdrawn. The refund will be mailed to exhibitor after the trial.

If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no entry fees will be refunded.

## **JUDGING**

Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside for judging when the steward calls for the class. It is not the responsibility of the steward or any agent of the Club to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in the ring. Judges need not wait for dogs holding up class to be judged.

Dogs may leave immediately after being judged unless needed for further judging.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Club assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this Trial is in The care and custody and control of the owner or handler at all times.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Arizona law requires rabies vaccine every 3 years. **No dog** should be at the Paradise Valley Park Small Event Field that is younger than 6 months old.

Exhibitors are requested to maintain clean conditions around their vehicles, tents, exercise pens and crates. Your cooperation will be appreciated. Only PFOC baby gates and ring set-up will be allowed in the Paradise Valley Park Small Event Field. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.

Do not leave any dog in closed vehicles. All persons attending these Trials hereby waive any claim for damages against PFOC or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

All dogs must be kept on a leash except when in the ring and must be brought into the ring and taken out of the ring on a leash. When outside of the ring, the handler must keep the dog on a leash and must hold the leash or confine the dog in a secure location such as a crate or exercise pen. No Flexi leads will be allowed on the Small Event Field. Friday afternoon, exhibitors may set up on the field after all PFOC rings and equipment are in place, sometime after 4 pm.

<u>PFOC</u> welcomes everyone's help to set up the rings and equipment on Friday afternoon. Emergency number at the Trial site is 608-606-9029. This number is for emergency use only on the day of the trial.

## **TRANFERS**

Dogs may be transferred to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for a Title at a different trial, provided the request, in writing (or email), is made to the Trial Secretary no later than noon, **Monday**, **Jan. 16**, **2017**. There will be move ups Saturday to Sunday provided the request, in writing, is made to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the judging at 8:30 am and if the judge has not reached the maximum dogs he/she may judge in his/her classes for that day.

## FOOD CONCESSION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records. have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, them, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14. Section 3.)
- 5. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC obedience and rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry from and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
