

# The deadline for submission for all scholarships is <u>April 15, 2024</u>.

To be considered for tuition assistance you must complete a FACTS application and your student(s) must be enrolled for the next school year, 2024-25.

### Please write your child's name inside their jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters.






