Accessory Structure

**037/25 Molnar/Randall:** That the development permit for accessory structure on Lot 3A Blk 3 Plan 102352092 be approved on two conditions: First that the final grade and drainage characteristics of the site be reviewed and inspected by the building inspector to ensure water from the hillside and site drains to the lake and not to the neighbouring property. Second, that the village approves the use of this structure for the purpose for which it was requested, that is to store boats, seadoos and other watercrafts, and not to store vehicles, as there is an existing garage on the site. The building permit will be issued upon approval by the building inspector.
