THE SEASON OF LENT



TIEMPO DE CUARESMA

LOS CUARENTA DIAS

La organización cuaresmal es un tiempo simbólico que he-cha sus raíces en el Antiguo y en el Nuevo Testamento. Los cuarenta días de Moisés y de Elías o los cuarenta años del Pueblo elegido en el desierto no son referencias secundarias. La tradición judeo-cristiana ha visto en este número una determinada significación. Probablemente la idea más antigua sea la referencia a los años de desierto vistos como un tiempo asociado al castigo de Dios (cf. Nm 14,34; Gn 7,4. 12. 17; Ez 4,6; 29, 11-13).

En el Deuteronomio aparece una interpretación de los cuarenta años como el tiempo de la prueba a la que Dios somete al pueblo (Dt 2,7; 8,2-4). Son los días del crecimiento de la fe, según el Salmo 94, 10. Para los Hechos de los Apóstoles, el número cuarenta continúa siendo simbólico. Lucas divide la vida de Moisés en tres períodos de cuarenta años (Hch 7,23 y 7,30); hace referencia a los cuarenta años del reinado de Saúl (Hch 13,21); y a los cuarenta días de la Ascensión (Hch 1, 3).

Estos cuarenta días podrían, entonces, considerarse como ese "hoy" del que habla la Carta a los Hebreos al referirse al Sal 94, como ese "tiempo propicio" para escuchar la voz de Dios y no endurecer el corazón.

En efecto, nuestra relación con Dios necesita no sólo de un "espacio" adecuado (el desierto como lugar de silencio), sino también de un "tiempo" oportuno y concreto, "suficiente" para escuchar, a través de nuestra conciencia, su voz de Padre que corrige y consuela a la vez.

El ayuno

Junto con el desierto y la oración, el ayuno parece ser una de las mediaciones privilegiadas de todo tiempo penitencial, de revisión de vida y de búsqueda sincera de Dios. Por eso, como hemos visto al referirnos al desierto, generalmente van unidos. Todos los que se retiran al desierto para encontrarse con Dios, ayunan.

Sin embargo, los profetas Joel e Isaías nos indican el verdadero sentido de esta antigua práctica penitencial: ... Vuelvan a mí de todo corazón, con ayuno, llantos y lamentos. Desgarren su corazón y no sus vestiduras, y vuelvan al Señor, su Dios. (Joel 2, 12-18)

Este es el ayuno que yo amo, oráculo del Señor: soltar las cadenas injustas, desatar los lazos del yugo, dejar en libertad a los oprimidos y romper todos los yugos; compartir tu pan con el hambriento y albergar a los pobres sin techo; cubrir al que veas desnudo... (Isaías 58, 6-9)

A la luz de sus palabras, comprendemos por qué, con el tiempo, el ayuno como abstención de comida ha cedido lugar al ayuno como símbolo y expresión de una renuncia a todo aquello que nos impide realizar en nosotros el proyecto de Dios, invitándonos a transformarlo en un gesto de solidaridad efectiva con los que pasan hambre

(es decir, ayunan forzosamente), trabajando por la eliminación de toda injusticia en la vida personal y social, y por la liberación de toda opresión, explotación y corrupción. Naturalmente, sería más fácil limitarnos a "cumplir" con el ayuno de alimentos propuesto por la Iglesia. Pero necesitamos descubrir esos "otros" ayunos como medio adecuado para cambiar lo que más nos cuesta. Tal vez se trate de hablar menos, de hacer menos gastos superfluos, de perder menos tiempo frente al televisor para entregarlo a alguien que necesite nuestra asistencia, etc. Por eso el ayuno tiene que ir unido a la limosna, al gesto caritativo, que es también una acción preferencial de la Cuaresma, según la tradición cristiana. Si ayunáramos sólo para sufrir o demostrar que somos fuertes, estaríamos desvirtuando su verdadera finalidad.

Once again it's time for Sole Reason's annual NEW sneaker drive to benefit local at risk children. Each year children's need for new shoes grows and your support is vital.

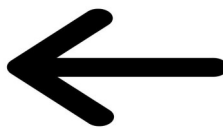
The collection for NEW sneakers will begin on Ash Wednesday and end April 14. There will be a box for collection by the south church door.
